



**Case Narrative**

On 10/09/2008 at approximately 0851 hours, I, Officer O'Day #12153, along with Officer Faberlle #11315, was dispatched to a residence located at 5309 Florence Harbor Drive, in reference to a suspicious incident. Officer Faberlle and I were further advised by police radio, the caller, Jennifer Killins, had reported hearing screaming and calls for help coming from the wooded area located on the north side of her listed residence.

Prior to our arrival, Officer Faberlle and I were additionally advised that a second caller, later identified as Renier Pistorius, who lives at 5358 Florence Harbor Drive, had also called 9-1-1 and reported hearing the calls for help that Jennifer had reported. Upon our arrival, we met with Jennifer and Renier in front of Jennifer's listed residence.

Jennifer and Renier were not aware that each other had called the police or had heard the same calls for help until Officer Faberlle and I arrived. Both Jennifer and Renier indicated that they heard the calls coming from the above described wooded area, and pointed in a northwest direction from the front of Jennifer's residence.

Jennifer stated that she was in front of her residence when she heard what she described as an adolescent voice calling for help, and that the calls for help sounded to her to be very stressed and genuine.

Renier described the voice as possibly being that of a young woman's or a child's and he also stated that the person calling for help appeared to be under some sort of duress.

Officer Faberlle and I attempted to listen for any further sounds coming from the wooded area, by walking the south side of the wooded area on foot and only heard what we later confirmed to be voices from children playing outside at Hidden Oaks Elementary School. Hidden Oaks Elementary School is located on the north side of the wooded area, at 9051 Suburban Drive in unincorporated Orange County.

Officer Faberlle and I also patrolled the neighborhood on the west side of the wooded area in our patrol vehicle, where we stopped and asked several unidentified people who were outside if they had heard any of the calls for help. None of the people we talked to said that they had heard anything like that which Jennifer and Renier had reported.

Officer Faberlle and I also patrolled the north side of the wooded area on foot, where Hidden Oaks Elementary School is located and still did not hear any voices coming from within the wooded area. The acting Kilo Sector Day-shift supervisor, Officer Tejeira #7473 and the North Watch Commander, Lieutenant Driscoll #1115, were contacted by Officer Faberlle and advised of the status of our call.

After receiving authorization from Lieutenant Driscoll, the Orange County Aviation Unit was requested and they arrived several minutes later, along with OPD K-9 Officer Michael #12670, Lieutenant Driscoll and several OCSO patrol units.

An extensive search by the Orange County Aviation Unit of the above described wooded area met with negative results. K-9 Officer Michael additionally searched the south side of the wooded area with his dog. This also met with negative results.

Officer Faberlle and I made contact with the main office staff at Hidden Oaks Elementary to inquire as to whether or not any children might have been outside the school yelling for help at approximately 0850 hours, which is when Jennifer and Renier reported hearing the voice. According to faculty member Tracey Wollam, there was a child who she identified only as Hermes (NOI), who was in front of the school at approximately 0845 hours yelling, because Hermes is what she referred to as a "High performance autistic child". Tracey stated that she did not recall Hermes yelling the word "Help", however, he was yelling very loudly, and some of the words could have been mistaken as "Help".

Tracey provided a sworn written statement describing Hermes' actions. The wooded area was not entered by any ground units due to its thick vegetation, and the fact that the ground is very wet and covered in deep water in some areas.
