2 ASB And I will sit here with you.  
3 CA Alright.  
4 CE Water?  
5 CA No I'm fine.  
6 AB I don't know if I should apologize for what happened on the highway or not, but...  
7 CA I almost feel like I should in a sense, but I don't think... yeah I know for a fact that  
8 he didn't know. So, I don't think that it was intentional on anybody's part for any  
9 of it so.  
10 ASB Yeah.  
11 CA I know that didn't look good, but I mean...  
12 AB Yeah.  
13 CA ...you can understand why...  
14 ASB I know one thing, if I got caught doing that I would've kept my ticket and  
15 (Inaudible)...  
16 CA (laugh)  
17 ASB (Inaudible)... especially when they found out I was a federal agent.  
18 CA Oh.  
19 ASB Oh really you driving like that around here. Get you ass in my car.  
20 CA Yeah. Well..  
21 ASB It's kind or how...  
22 CA ...we figured going through the airport is restricted air space so they can't take  
23 the helicopters through. And we thought that the cars are following us from my  
24 attorney's office were media.  
25 ASB Yeah.

1 CA Because there's a media van that followed us and another van that went with  
2 them. So, we're thinking, oh shit here we go.

3 ASB Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

4 CA It's happened before. It happens every day.

5 ASB I know it does.

6 CA So.

7 ASB I know it does. I'd like to make it stop happening to be honest with you.

8 CA I would too.

9 (Chuckle)

10 ASB Well, you know what I'll say to that?

11 CA (No verbal response).

12 ASB I've said that to your mom, I've said it to your dad and I said it to your brother  
13 even.

14 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

15 ASB You know.

16 CA Well that was one thing that they all agreed upon was the fact that you extended  
17 you know your hand out. Most people haven't. So.

18 ASB Right. I was afraid that some of what I said to them probably offended them  
19 because I told them that if I find out something that you don't want to hear.

20 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

21 ASB I'm gonna tell you anyway.

22 CA Well..

23 ASB Just because...

24 CA ...honestly they respect that that's just you know...

25 ASB Yeah.

1 CA ...the type of people that they are, I'm the same way.

2 ASB I know.. I know they are, but ah, when I hit 'em with certain things they don't  
3 hear. And I understand that.

4 CA Yeah, well..

5 ASB It doesn't mean I'm not gonna say...

6 CA Exactly. We know different beliefs and somebody it's just hard sometimes to  
7 hear their opinion. But..

8 ASB That's trued.

9 CA ...that doesn't mean that they don't respect your opinion or the fact that you're  
10 coming forward with what you think or what you feel so.

11 ASB Yeah. Well, to some extent it's comforting to hear you say that because it was  
12 never my intention to piss anybody in your family off.

13 CA Yeah.

14 ASB You know I'm not in it to get a conviction, I get nothing out of it. I get zero.

15 CA Exactly even on the job you're trying to do.

16 ASB Right.

17 CA You know.

18 ASB I found a few and I..

19 CA Yeah.

20 ASB I not a few and it sucked both ways.

21 CA Yeah I agree.

22 ASB So.. it is what it is.

23 CA Yeah.

24 ASB Where I get side.. sideways with people.

25 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

1 ASB Tends to be when attorneys get involved.

2 CA I've heard most people say that. They don't like attorneys very much.

3 ASB I had, I had many family members that are attorneys I have no problems with  
4 attorneys. What I have problems with are at some point.

5 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

6 ASB We have to set aside the rules and we have to find kids. And you know what?  
7 So be it that's why I told you in the car. You know if you tell me anything now.

8 CA Yeah.

9 ASB I'll get up and say, yep I heard it and she's already invoked and we can't use any  
10 of it. That's just the way it is that's all that matters to me.

11 CA Yeah.

12 ASB And ah, you know when we did, did the another case that I was involved in. You  
13 know they lost a confession. And I sat there and I looked right at the guys that  
14 we worked with I said..

15 CA That's not what's important.

16 ASB ...who caress.

17 CA yeah.

18 ASB we found her. We found her and he's gonna get what is coming to him that's not  
19 my job.

20 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

21 ASB You know. And it works out in the end. It works out in the end on all sides.

22 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

23 ASB To be honest with you. It may not be comfortable for everybody.

24 CA Yeah.

25

1 ASB But I've done things that if I get caught for. I'm not gonna I'm not gonna be  
2 comfortable I can tell you that.

3 (Laugh)

4 ASB It's just the way life is. You know but it's not the end of the road either. And  
5 that's what we have to keep in mind it's not the end of the road you know.

6 CA Just a random question.

7 ASB Shoot.

8 CA Um, are there cameras in all of the rooms or just some of 'em?

9 ASB I have no frigging clue. I've never been in this part of the building so I...

10 CA Well I know that (Inaudible)...

11 ASB My guess would be yes.

12 DR We're gonna go get something to drink, do you want any soda, Mountain Dew,  
13 Diet Pepsi?

14 CA Nothing.

15 ASB No I'm fine.

16 CA I'm good.

17 ASB Thank you very much.

18 CA I know my mom is...

19 ASB I would guess yes.

20 CA Yeah that's what I was thinking to. Well, my mom wasn't aware that there was a  
21 camera in the room I guess when she met with Melich and I forget who else.  
22 And the big interviews that were released to the media and she was infuriated.

23 ASB Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

24 CA You would think that that's something that you know you should've told. But you  
25 don't have to be.

1 ASB Right.

2 CA (laugh)

3 ASB The law is the law.

4 CA Yeah.

5 ASB And I will play within the rules of the law.

6 CA Yeah.

7 ASB If.. if it's a tool that's available to me that I can use later to look back on and see if

8 I missed something or could I have done something better. I'm gonna take

9 advantage of it.

10 CA Yeah exactly.

11 ASB I would assume that this place probably has one somewhere...

12 CA Oh easily.

13 ASB ...around here.

14 CA It would be something that records audio so either way.

15 ASB Yeah. I could tell you (Inaudible)...

16 CA (laugh)

17 ASB (Inaudible)... Um, yeah there probably be somewhat unhappy when they see my

18 interviews with 'em. Those haven't been release yet, but they were on video.

19 CA Yeah. Well, that's just part of the discovery so.

20 ASB Yeah it'll all come out.

21 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

22 ASB You know. But ah, like I said I have loyalty to one person in every one of these

23 cases and it doesn't happen to be anybody I'm interviewing usually.

24 CA Understand.

25

1 ASB It's not a, it's not a slight on them. You know dealt with many different people. In  
2 many different positions.

3 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

4 ASB None of which are comfortable and those things always get in the way that you  
5 have on your.. hands.

6 CA (No verbal response).

7 ASB you know. Such are the rules that we work under.

8 CA Yeah. Here's my question.

9 ASB Sure.

10 CA Um, I know this is a question that a lot of people have asked. The grand jury and  
11 all that is suppose to be secrete. But it was released to the media right off the  
12 bat. My dad hadn't even been subpoenaed and that was released. So, I just  
13 think a lot of that's kind of funny. And the fact that they invited the media in when  
14 they were releasing the decision. My mom had received a text message from  
15 someone...

16 ASB Someone in the media.

17 CA ...in the media. Yeah.

18 ASB Saying they're (Inaudible)... all of a sudden they make the decision. We're  
19 thinking, are you serious?

20 ASB There are rules.

21 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

22 ASB I am quite sure that one of the rules that was followed was that when the decision  
23 to indict has been made.

24 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

25 ASB Um, that part of it is public.

1 CA Yeah that part's public.  
2 ASB And they can let the media into the courtroom at that point.  
3 CA Yeah.  
4 ASB I bet this is just my bet. I don't know what the Florida rules are I'm...  
5 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
6 ASB ...more federal stuff familiar with that.  
7 CA Yeah.  
8 ASB But what I bet is that it was done under seal.  
9 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
10 ASB And there was no names and no official charges probably read aloud.  
11 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
12 ASB It probably just was there's been an indictment received in a case and that's it.  
13 CA Well, when the media was out there all day and they knew about this a week ago  
14 that it was going to happen.  
15 ASB Yeah.  
16 CA So it's just kind of funny. It's suppose to be a secrete. And ...  
17 ASB The.. the...  
18 CA ....everything was...  
19 ASB ....the happenings...  
20 CA ...releases.  
21 ASB The happenings are secrete.  
22 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
23 ASB What takes place within the room is secrete.  
24 CA Yeah. But as far as when it actually is convened and you know pulled together  
25 and the witnesses and stuff like that that's not all suppose to be secrete?

1 ASB It depends on how they're subpoenaed.

2 CA Okay.

3 ASB I mean if you're subpoenaed under a regular court order. That's a (Inaudible)...

4 CA My dad was through his attorney so I'm not quite sure how that came through.

5 Yeah I know...

6 ASB But if, but if the subpoena itself..

7 CA Yeah.

8 ASB ...is just a regular (Inaudible)...

9 CA Yeah certain things...

10 ASB ...grand jury subpoena, that's

11 CA ....are public..

12 ASB ...public records.

13 CA Yeah.

14 ASB It doesn't say what it[s for, it doesn't say what case it's in.

15 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

16 ASB It doesn't.. it just says you're subpoenaed to appear before the grand jury.

17 CA Well, with them announcing that you know there's gonna be a grand jury and

18 obviously my name was thrown out they knew ho the grand jury was for.

19 ASB Who threw your name out?

20 CA All the media said that it was from an inside source meaning, in here.

21 ASB I...

22 CA So, that's here they all say it's...

23 ASB I can tell you what I think of the media and what I think of people who leak stuff to

24 the media.

25 CA I think it's garbage. Yeah I agree.

1 ASB But...

2 CA That's the best way...

3 ASB But it doesn't...

4 CA ....of putting it.

5 ASB ...that doesn't make any.. less necessary.

6 CA (No verbal response).

7 ASB Without them.

8 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

9 ASB I'll be quite honest without the media, we don't find a quarter of the kids that we

10 ...

11 CA Oh I agree.

12 ASB ....(Inaudible)...

13 CA It helps the exposure has helped bring in so many tips for my daughter.

14 ASB But at the same time..

15 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

16 ASB ...what it creates is it creates a monster that otherwise isn't necessary.

17 CA Exactly.

18 ASB The tips are what the tips are.

19 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

20 ASB If it was a local media only.

21 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

22 ASB It would be much easier to work.

23 CA Yeah.

24 ASB When you make it the national media, then you come up with...

25 CA You get the Nancy Graces.

1 ASB Well you get the, well you get the tips also.  
2 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
3 ASB That come from Hawaii that say, I saw Caylee.  
4 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
5 ASB Oh really.  
6 (chuckle)  
7 ASB Okay let me call Hawaii.  
8 CA (Inaudible)... Georgia...  
9 ASB Let me send 'em out and do the...  
10 CA ...and the ones that are a little bit closer...  
11 ASB Those are, those are ...  
12 CA ....range.  
13 ASB ...what I consider a local. Because...  
14 CA Yeah.  
15 ASB ...the local stations are...  
16 CA It's in close range.  
17 ASB ....gonna cover that.  
18 CA Yeah.  
19 ASB That's contiguous to the state of Florida it's not...  
20 CA When people are only getting their information from the Nancy Graces or from  
21 Globe Magazine or People or you know stuff like that. Are you kidding me.  
22 ASB Well, I can say you will not see me trying to be interviewed by ..  
23 CA Yeah.  
24 ASB ...by People or Globe or anybody else. It's not gonna happen.  
25 CA (Inaudible)...

1 (Knock)

2 AS Yo.

3 CE Long trip (Inaudible)... my friend. Whoo... That was a long ride without doing  
4 that. Then the adrenalin dump all at the same time.

5 ASB Twelve people want to know what we're talking here.

6 CE You know. (pointing to Casey)

7 CA I'm just gonna let that go. (laugh)

8 CE No but I need to... You gonna have... you're not gonna break bad right?

9 CA No.

10 CE Alright. We're gonna call him on my cell phone.

11 CA Okay. I know this is.. oh yeah that's not good.

12 CE Pull back there.

13 CA (laugh)

14 CE Just slide your hands out. No I'll go get a key...

15 CA Like I honestly...

16 CE ...that fits.

17 CA ..can't.

18 CE (All laughing)

19 CA So, they're a little tight.

20 CE Thanks for entertaining us just slide your hands out.

21 ASB Way to go Corporal Edwards.

22 CA Actually if I could I would've done that for you. (Inaudible)...

23 CE You know Baez's phone number off the top of your head?

24 CA No I do not.

25 CE How can I get the cell number? Or his number?

1 CA Um, I know his office number.  
2 CE What is that?  
3 CA Four 07...  
4 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
5 CA ....705-2626.  
6 ASB Did you see Mr. Savage... while you were out there?  
7 CE Yeah. You... you want to go speak with him and get me a handcuff key that fits?  
8 AS I like that.  
9 CE And I'll have her make the phone call to Mr. Baez.  
10 ASB You do that.  
11 CE Now once again..  
12 ASB Where is he?  
13 CE He should be...  
14 AS Ah, if I get there.  
15 (laugh)  
16 CE ...in the office talking to the chief.  
17 CA I think he needs a bat to get back there.  
18 CE This is a rat maze.  
19 ASB Oh right here.  
20 CA Yeah he doesn't know how to get back there.  
21 CE I've identified myself you know why you're in custody.  
22 CA Yes.  
23 CE Um, and you have, you signed this you want your attorney present.  
24 CA Yes.  
25 CE Through that conversation we've agreed.

1 CA Yes.

2 CE Because express that to me again so I have full understanding before I get on  
3 the phone with him.

4 CA We discussed before that we have no problems sitting down together him and I  
5 and speaking with law enforcement or listening to all the questions that you have  
6 him and I discussing it, and then we go from there so.

7 CE Okay. And that's.. there's been no success with that so far and you...

8 CA Nobody's taking us up on that.

9 CE So, what we're gonna, we're gonna open that window right now.

10 CA Okay.

11 CE And hopefully we can make something happen. (Calling Atty. Baez) 'Cause  
12 ultimately think we have the same interest.

13 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

14 CE Finding your daughter. Two 6-2-6 you said?

15 CA Yes. Thank you. (handed phone to Casey)

16 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

17 CA Hey Ed it's Casey. Um, can you do me a favor and call Jose or can you give me  
18 Jose's cell phone number so I can call him? Oh is he okay great. Thanks.

19 CE How long ago was that?

20 CA I was 17. Five years.

21 CE Why'd you cut your hair?

22 CA Hey, it's Casey. Um, I'm with Corporal..

23 CE Edwards.

24 CA ... Corporal Edwards. I knew your last name sorry. Um, I'm at the Sheriff's  
25 Department if you'd like to come done and meet with us. Thank you. Yes.

1 CE He want to talk to me (Inaudible).. to.  
2 CA Okay, great thanks. (hand the phone to Cpl Edwards)  
3 CE Hello.  
4 CA Yeah. (laugh) Give him the information.  
5 CE Orange County Sheriff's. (Talking to Atty. Baez). Yeah at John Young and 50.  
6 yeah we.. we um, Mr. Baez we Mirandized her as we're.. at 4:22 and she stated  
7 that you've done a great job. She invoked and, but she also said that she you  
8 know that her exasperation is the same as ours. You guys wanted the  
9 opportunity to speak with law enforcement face to face. And let's.. if you guys  
10 are interested in doing that let's get that done. Quit the finger pointing okay.  
11 Alright sir. (hung up)  
12 CA Thanks.  
13 CE We're game on.  
14 ASB Casey.  
15 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
16 ASB The good looking young man that just walked in and sitting across from you now.  
17 Is Nick Savage.  
18 CE What's he doing here?  
19 AB He's from here.  
20 CA (Laughing)  
21 DR Does anybody else need a drink?  
22 CE This for you.  
23 ASB If it's okay with you..  
24 CR She didn't want a.  
25 ASB I'm gonna turn this...

1 CA Yeah that's fine.  
2 ASB ..ball game over to him.  
3 CA I appreciate your help.  
4 ASB No problem.  
5 CA Nice meeting you.  
6 CE Mr. Baez is on the way.  
7 ASB Alright.  
8 CR (Inaudible)...  
9 FA (Inaudible)...  
10 AS (Inaudible)...  
11 CA I'm alright.  
12 AS You guys need anything?  
13 CE I'm good.  
14 AS I'm gonna get out.  
15 CA Alright thank you.  
16 AS If you need anything call.  
17 CA Thanks.  
18 CE Alright. How does he spell his last?  
19 CA B-A-E-Z.  
20 AS Hard one.  
21 CA And to answer your other question. Um, from that picture I cut my hair it was  
22 really short even last year I just started growing back out this year so. Yes about  
23 that.  
24 SA Okay.  
25 CA (laugh)

1 AS As far as Mr. Baez?  
2 CA He's at...  
3 CE Um...  
4 CA ...the office.  
5 CE ....he's at the office.  
6 AS Okay.  
7 CE So, we have a bit of time.  
8 AS Okay that's fine.  
9 CE And we...  
10 AS We can (Inaudible)...  
11 CE We ah, went through the formalities of this make sure everything is above board.  
12 And like I said before, that's what you're gonna get here okay. We just would  
13 request the same back.  
14 CA Yep.  
15 AS You understand what you were arrest for today?  
16 CA Yes.  
17 AS Okay.  
18 CE My I step out for a minute?  
19 AS Absolutely.  
20 CE And I'll be back.  
21 CA Yep.  
22 CE You sure you don't want anything to drink?  
23 CA I'm fine thank you.  
24 AS Handcuff key?  
25 CE Where'd my handcuff go?

1 AS Um, (Inaudible)...

2 CE got to (Inaudible)... pawn shop right now.

3 CA (laugh) Oh boy. It's been a long day.

4 (Cpl. Left room)

5 AS It had been.

6 CA How was my dad this morning?

7 AS Um, he had a hard time.

8 CA Yeah.

9 AS Honestly.

10 CA I only saw from the media and got a chance to hear him talking to my mom. I

11 spoke to him last night and this morning for just a quick second before he left so.

12 AS Yeah I talked to him this morning for a little bit ah, he was with Mark and yeah he

13 was really struggling. I mean you can imagine he was having a hard time. Ah,

14 yeah he was being called in to, to essentially provide testimony to indict you.

15 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

16 AS At the least... and he was really struggling with that.

17 CA Yeah.

18 AS And ah, and I felt bad for him to be honest with you I truly did.

19 CA Well I told him last night I know he was subpoenaed and under the law he had to

20 answer whatever questions were asked. And I told him to do what he had to do

21 at that point. And if he didn't he'd be held in contempt of court.

22 AS Well...

23 CA I don't want to see that happen so.

24 AS What'd he say?

25

1 CA he just hugged me and told me that he loved me and I know he was struggling  
2 with it even last night so.

3 AS I think it was probably (Inaudible).. this morning.

4 CA Yeah. I could see that with the little bit that I saw from the media from the  
5 pictures and um, the little bit of footage that they had so.

6 AS You guys watch it on TV?

7 CA Oh we watched online a little bit.

8 AS Really?

9 CA Yeah. I try to stay away from the TV as much as possible. At least with internet  
10 I can scroll through read what I want and than just get rid of it that much faster  
11 so.

12 AS You anxious about today at all?

13 CA Um, I have been. I mean this is something honestly we been preparing for from  
14 the beginning just because of words that were directly spoken from Yuri Melich  
15 and also from Sergeant Allen. They were saying that this is what they were  
16 planning on doing from the very beginning from that first day. So, they wrote me  
17 off within the first couple of hours so.

18 AS Ah, I don't know if that's true.

19 CA It was the direct words that they pretty much gave to myself and even they said  
20 that to my parents. So, I mean I'm not trying to say something derogatory  
21 towards someone. But...

22 AS No, okay. We're just, we're just talking.

23 CA Yeah.

24 AS We're just chatting so.

25

1 CA That was the only time they ever made any effort to try to talk to me one on one.  
2 And...

3 AS Now it's kind of difficult.

4 CA It was kind of difficult considering .

5 AS All considering um, obviously in light of everything that's going on and the fact  
6 that ...

7 CA Yeah.

8 AS ...you've been arrested for other things makes it a little more difficult to sit down  
9 and even talk to you.

10 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

11 AS It's not that we haven't wanted to.

12 CA Yeah.

13 AS Um, I certainly ...

14 CA I do have counsel and that's something that you know my attorney's always been  
15 a phone call away. And it shouldn't have taken it getting to this point, you know  
16 three months in.

17 AS Has...

18 CA For us..

19 AS Has your attorney ever told you that we would like to speak to you?

20 CA And we had agreed him and I together that we would all sit down together him  
21 and I and you guys and you know we entertain..

22 AS (Inaudible)...

23 CA ....whatever questions you have and discuss things and...

24 AS I actually thought that we made it pretty clear.

25 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

1 AS That you know we wanted to talk to you. I mean obviously we can't come to you  
2 and ask you. But...

3 CA Yeah I understandably.

4 AS ...you know I thought that you were aware that if you wanted to talk to anybody/  
5 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

6 AS That all you got to do was simply ask.

7 CA Yeah. Well, I know it goes both easy on that and I guess it would've needed to  
8 come from me. I should've been the one to I guess come forward with it. But you  
9 know we did open up that door to law enforcement before. When Sergeant Allen  
10 was making a big deal saying, well we want to talk her. When can we talk to her.  
11 He's saying well the door is open.

12 AS Hm, I don't believe he ever told us the door's open. I mean...

13 CA Well maybe not to you directly, but I know to Sergeant Allen I was sitting there,  
14 even one of the times that he spoke with him. So, I've heard the words come out  
15 of his mouth even myself directed to other people that maybe didn't either relay  
16 the message or took it a different way. So, I don't know. I think the lack of  
17 communication has put people in opposite corners when everybody has the  
18 same goal, is to find Caylee.

19 AS Do you think the matter could've been resolved a little differently?

20 CA Absolutely in a lot of different aspects. And that's a conversation that I've had  
21 not only with my attorney, but with my family.

22 AS Alright.

23 CA So, I mean we all still feel, I as a mom I know in my gut there's the feeling as a  
24 parent you know certain things about your child you can feel that connection.  
25 And I still have that feeling that presence I know that she's alive. Whether you

1 have a bucket load of evidence downstairs that contradicts that and says  
2 otherwise. Or all you have is speculation. Or, or nothing at all. I mean  
3 whatever it is if there's still that chance with all these tips that have come  
4 through I know that it's been speculated how many thousands of tips have come  
5 through.

6 AS There's been a lot.

7 CA There have been a lot I know I've seen the...

8 AS But you also know how many have been ...

9 CA I know that a lot have been discredited, but..

10 AS We ran them down and ...

11 CA Is every...

12 AS ...and we had more speculation.

13 CA Has every tip been...

14 AS And that's something ...

15 CA ...ever lead been followed up?

16 AS ....Jose directly.

17 CA Yeah.

18 AS That we have more then speculation. We have a lot or else we wouldn't be to  
19 this point.

20 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

21 AS A lot.

22 CA All I said, I said the same thing to them that you know they said we're at the end  
23 of a hallway. And I'm thinking we're at the end of a hallway and there's two  
24 doors. Which door are we going to go through or I guess this is you know we're  
25 at this point. And ...

1 AS We are at this point. We're (Inaudible)...

2 CA The final step is which door is what?

3 AS We are well beyond where we were before.

4 CA !Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

5 AS I mean those issues are gone okay.

6 (Cpl Edwards returned to room)

7 AS And when we refer to we're at the end of the hallway. I think you are well aware

8 of what hallway we're talking about. Do you understand that?

9 CA Um, well so there's a question I guess. You can specify that at this point. Or

10 what your perspective is on that.

11 CE You have a second?

12 AS Absolutely.

13 CE Can we come right back?

14 CA Yeah that's fine.

15 CE You planning on running off?

16 CA I'm not going anywhere.

17 CE I got to stretch out a little bit I'm not as young as I used to be.

18 CA (laugh)

19 AS I can tell.

20 CE Oh I thought you were gonna say something smart.

21 AS No I was gonna ask if that was your Dr. Pepper or Mountain Dew or...

22 CE I actually tried to give it to her she didn't want it.

23 CA I.. I'm perfectly fine I...

24 CE Do you want it?

25 AS No I ...

1 CA ....don't drink soda so.  
2 AS ...was gonna ask...  
3 CE So, we share it?  
4 AS We can.  
5 CA (laugh)  
6 FA Two straws? Or just...  
7 AS Sure.  
8 CE So, I'll be right back. Do you want that or no 'cause if you don't...  
9 CA No.  
10 CE Your mom probably has one.  
11 CA She probably has one, but I'm not gonna be with mom probably so.  
12 CE I'm pretty sure you're not gonna be with your mom when you leave here. I don't  
13 want to mislead you there. That's...  
14 CA You're not misleading me at all, which is why I...  
15 CE Unless your mom runs me off the road on the way out of here then you may  
16 share a car trip down there.  
17 CA That's why I told my mom to go home and not to come here. She wanted to  
18 come here. So, I mean...  
19 CE She, she knew you were coming here eventually.  
20 CA Um, I was the one that was telling her that I was coming here eventually. Just  
21 from the way ...  
22 CE You had enough perception to turn the flashers on. I.. that's... I applaud you for  
23 that.  
24 AS You did that?  
25 CE The only one (Inaudible)...

1 CA She didn't know how to put her flashers on. (laugh)  
2 CE It was crazy out there.  
3 CA It's right on the center part of the dash.  
4 CE I've been in a lot of vehicle takedowns. That was similar to one. It was  
5 ridiculous. Wasn't it?  
6 CA Because I help her out a little bit and help out whoever was behind her so they  
7 wouldn't hit her.  
8 AS I missed that.  
9 CA (laugh)  
10 CE Be back in a second okay.  
11 (Detectives left room)  
12 **(Detectives are waiting for Casey Anthony's attorney to get there for the**  
13 **interview.)**  
14 (Cpl. Edwards returned for a minute)  
15 CE Okay we're gonna be a few minutes 'cause we just got to wait for...  
16 CA Yeah that's fine.  
17 CE ....Mr. Baez to get there. Water, anything?  
18 CA Nope I'm fine.  
19 CE You good?  
20 CA Yep.  
21 CE Facilities?  
22 CA Nope I'm good.  
23 CE Okay.  
24 CA Thanks.  
25 CE Yep.

1 AS You see my (Inaudible)...

2 CE Yep they're right there.

3 CA (laugh)

4 **(Left again – Waiting for Attorney Baez to arrive)**

5 **(They returned)**

6 CA Hey.

7 AB He's gonna ask you a question.

8 CA Okay.

9 AB And don't say anything else other than the answer okay.

10 CE Casey, based on our conversation today and I read you that form.

11 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

12 CE It's just same thing I said to Mr. Baez over the phone. If there's been numerous

13 requests.. or request or opportunities request for opportunities to speak with us

14 and come to a resolution here. And that's why we brought you here instead of

15 the jail, correct?

16 CA Yes.

17 CE Okay. Now based on your request for us to call him and bring him here, he's

18 here. So, what we're gonna try to do is give you a few minutes somewhere that's

19 not recorded. No secretes I told you, this room's rerecorded.

20 CA (Inaudible)...

21 CE I have to be able to approach my chain and explain why. But first I needed you

22 to tell him in your own words if you will. That you'd like to take the opportunity to

23 deal with us like you made that request in the past. So, is that something you

24 want to tell him?

25

1 CA I told him the same thing we talked about before that we would entertain any  
2 questions that they have. We would listen and discuss it and if we have  
3 something to respond, we respond.

4 AB Okay do you want to speak to me in private?

5 CA Yes.

6 AB So, we can clarify this.

7 CA Yes.

8 CE Okay.

9 AB Have a seat.

10 CE Let me get my room to go let ya'll just (Inaudible)...

11 CA I'm just gonna stand up for a second I been sitting for an hour. Thank you.

12 CE Alright.

13 CA (laugh)

14 AB Thanks.

15 CE You welcome.

16 (Left room)

17 (Someone came to door to get Casey)

18 (Talking in hallway)

19 (Corporal Edwards came in and left room again.)

20 (Everyone Returned)

21 CA (laugh) Funny.

22 CE Have a seat.

23 AB Okay.

24 CE We had a discussion.

25 CA Okay.

1 CE You want to discuss that with her.  
2 AB Um, she knows.  
3 CE Okay.  
4 AB I'll just go ahead and state for the record that ah, she's invoking her Right to  
5 counsel. And at this time wishes to ah, request to go to jail and be processed.  
6 CE And we agreed upon that at 4:22 in the afternoon already.  
7 CA Yes.  
8 CE That's why we called him. I don't have a problem with that.  
9 AB Okay.  
10 CE You have any questions of me in regard to this? She signed that and we're  
11 good. Okay.  
12 AB No questions.  
13 CE Okay. Super, we'll be right with you.  
14 CA Okay.  
15 CE Help yourself to some candy.  
16 AB (Inaudible)... Listen we're gonna take you.  
17 CA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
18 AB Remember you're.. we're gonna take you right now so.  
19 CA Okay.  
20 AB I'll visit you if not tonight tomorrow.  
21 CA Okay.  
22 AB Okay we'll see you soon.  
23 CA Bye.  
24 (Left room again)

25

1 CE We're working out getting you down there.  
2 CA Alright.  
3 CE Okay.  
4 CA Yeah.  
5 CE I want to take you in probably the same ugly mugs that you already had to look  
6 at.  
7 CA (laugh)  
8 CE Alright.  
9 CA Thanks.  
10 CE Alright. Are you wearing your coat out?  
11 AS I always wear my coat.  
12 CE See that's why I brought one.  
13 CA (laugh)  
14 AS Sorry.  
15 CE Did you bring a coat?  
16 CA No.  
17 ASB I wear Khakis and a T-shirt.  
18 FA We're the FBI. You're so pretentious.  
19 CE I looked that word up too.  
20 ASB You know what? You just need to carry one of those digital thesaurus and  
21 dictionary around.  
22 CE I am. (Inaudible)...  
23 AS You guys. Okay that's probably recorded so.  
24 CE Yeah. I have evidence. Oh, I have to handcuff you again.  
25 CA Yes.

1 AS You just try this.

2 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

3 CA I don't care.

4 AS I drink a lot of coffee though.

5 FA I was gonna tell you, you needed to do something about that.

6 CE What's that?

7 FA His breath.

8 CA (laugh)

9 CE Why did you wait so many years? Yeah we'll put 'em.. I'll tell you what.

10 (Putting handcuffs on Casey to take her to jail)

11 CE Actually you know what? And this, this didn't work.

12 (Inaudible)...

13 AS (Inaudible)...

14 AS We work terrorism.

15 AS I don't.

16 CA (laugh) That's (Inaudible)...

17 CE Okay.

18 CA Huh. Thanks.

19 AS You're welcome.

20 CE Up need this.

21 CA Don't lose that.

22 ASB Nick Savage the gentleman.

23 CE Need that. Take this and he radio.

24 FA (Inaudible)...

25 CE Okay well let's head out. After you ma'am. Make a right. Dottie downstairs?

1 (Everyone left room)  
2 (Talking in hallway)  
3 (Leaving to take Casey Anthony to jail)
