

1 CE Okay. We'd had.. we'd done kind of a pre-interview with you. We met yesterday.
2 Sergeant Allen and I showed up on your front porch and we spoke to your sister.
3 What's your sister's name?
4 CB Krystal Holloway.
5 CE I'm sorry?
6 CB Krystal Holloway.
7 CE And Krystal um, is known to... the reason we met you was due to the Anthony
8 homicide case investigation. You're aware of that?
9 CB Yes.
10 CE Okay. Krystal's also know by what name?
11 CB River Cruz.
12 CE River Cruz. Okay. Um, you and your sister came here yesterday or the last
13 night and we interviewed her. Um, and we had some questions for you regarding
14 your knowledge of how your.. ah, how Krystal was involved with George Anthony
15 and the Anthony situation. And what I'd like to do is just stop talking, which is
16 hard for me. And ah, let you explain that to us in your own words.
17
18 CB Um, where am I starting?
19 CE Ahhh...
20 CB At the beginning?
21 CE ...well we'll leave that, we'll leave your visit to the jail until.. we'll come back and
22 get that. So, just let me know what your personal knowledge of your sister um,
23 and her involvement with the Anthony's.
24
25

1 CB Well, they.. from my understanding they were friends and I believe it was a little
2 more then friendship. From what I was seeing. The um, the texts, the letters, the
3 cards, the gifts. I.. I..
4 CE Okay.
5 CBassumed.
6 CE Between her and ...
7 CB That she... her and, her and George. I.. I.. I'm assume..
8 SA Alright...
9 CB ...I assumed at that point that they had some type of affair.
10 CE A physical relationship?
11 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative).. Yes.
12 CE Okay. Did you see George at the house, your house?
13 CB Um, yes.
14 CE How many times?
15 CB Twice.
16 CE When was that?
17 CB Oh it was after I um, should I say...
18 CE Pardon me?
19 CB Should I say that word? It was after I came out of jail.
20 CE Yeah that's fine.
21 CB Okay.
22 CE Yeah please yeah after you came out of jail.
23 CB Yeah.

1 CE Okay. And that was when?
2 CB Um, it was after Jan.. it was January um, like '08.
3 CE Hmmm, that would've been...
4 CB '07?
5 CE ...'09.
6 CB '09.
7 CE Yeah from our conversation.
8 CB Right, right, right okay.
9 CE Yeah, 'cause you.. you.. yeah 'cause you'd been out about a...
10 CB A year yes.
11 CE ... a year.
12 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
13 CE So, January '09.
14 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
15 CE Okay. So, from January '09 to present was it shortly after you were released that
16 you saw George at the house twice? Or was it ...
17 CB Yes.
18 CElast week or...
19 CB On no that was after I was released that he had came over.
20 CE Now had your friend ah, your sister been friends with him prior to you being
21 released from jail? This...
22
23
24
25

1 CB She was friends with him while I was in the, in the prison, in the jail, in the jail
2 she... I don't know if she befriended him or he befriended her. But while I was
3 incarcerated that's when she became friends with him.
4 CE And you, when did you learn of that friendship?
5 CB After I came out of jail.
6 CE So, while you were, while you were in the Orange County Jail you had no
7 knowledge of your...
8 CB No.
9 CE ...your sister...
10 CB Nope.
11 CEand George Anthony? Okay, when you first came out how did your sister
12 approach you and tell you that she had become involved or was friends with the
13 Anthony's?
14 CB Because I stated to her, she was asking me what I was doing in the jail and I
15 stated to her that I was cleaning ah, my.. my job at the facility what my job was
16 and that I happened to be feeding and talking to Casey.
17 CE Casey Anthony?
18 CB Yes and then she told me that, that's funny I'm friends with the father.
19 CM And what did she tell you about the friendship with the father or the family what
20 was...
21 CB The same day I was released.
22 CM No, no, what did she tell you? How did she meet or what.. what.. what kind of a
23 friendship was it?
24
25

1 CB She told me... she told me that they met at a tent um, something about Kid
2 Finders Network, my sister was doing something with them and either he was
3 standing there and that moment either.. I'm not sure what happened, but he
4 was... he.. she went over to console him. That was the first moment that they
5 became friends.

6 CM And did she say how.. how.. how hat became a friendship as opposed to just an
7 acquaintance? How they got to know each other and what they did?

8 CB Um, she was inviting him, they was inviting each other. They took the numbers
9 down they was talking on the phone a lot and um, she told me that he had been
10 at the house a few times. She told me that he.. she had given money a few
11 times. Um, and she also told me that she's been over to his house.

12 CM And this is all before you got out of jail?

13 CB Yeah and..

14 CM So...

15 CB and after.

16 CM So, by the time you got out of jail they had already established a friendship?

17 CB Right.

18 CM And she had already started... was she giving money or loaning money, do you
19 know?

20 CB No, she was giving him money.

21 CM How much money we talking about?

22 CB If you're asking me I think all together I would say about, I'd say about five grand
23 all together..

1 CM And do you know what that money was suppose to be used for?

2 CB Not sure.

3 CM But did she tell you why she was giving him money?

4 CB I couldn't understand that.

5 CM Did she tell you that?

6 CB Um, she just would say, he didn't have any money. Oh, one time I did know that

7 he.. he asked her I think for eight hundred dollars he asked her for eight hundred.

8 And um, there was a problem with her getting, retrieving it. And um, I think it was

9 like a few days later she end up giving it to him. I remember that.

10

11 CE How did she get the money that time?

12 CB Um, I think it was um, either the tax or the baby.. She's got people in New York

13 that she you know they give 'em money.

14 CE Child support?

15 CB Um, not child support but the father was sending money and you know Jeff gives

16 her money too.

17 CE Just to go back. When they first met why did your sister opt to use the name

18 River Cruz?

19 CB That's um, sh... we never like our names. We was adopted. Um, she went by

20 River that's something that my father used to call her. I used to stare at the sky

21 all the time so I kind of just adopted the name Sky. So, we just went with it.

22

23 CE Okay so it's nothing that she generated for this particular ...

24 CB No.

25 CE ...occurrence?

1 CB She's been that... that has always been her last... her name.
2 CE River.
3 CB It's like mine, Sky.
4 CE Where'd the Cruz part come from?
5 CB Um, have to ask her that one.
6 CE Okay.
7 CB I think it's one of the um, one it's a character. A singer or something.
8 CE Okay so she just chose not to tell them her real identity.
9 CB Right. She would never go under, like me, I've never, nobody really knows my
10 name.
11 CE Ok. Sorry Yuri I wanted to...
12 CM No that's fine.
13 CE ...make sure that we understood why she... And she's still known to George is
14 my...
15 CB Yeah.
16 CE ...understanding as River.
17 CB He has no idea what her real name is. He doesn't know her as Krystal Holloway.
18 CE Okay. Does um, her boyfriend's name is Jeff is correct?
19 CB Yes.
20 CE What's Jeff's last name?
21 CB Allen.
22 CE Jeff Allen?
23 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

1 CE Um, was Jeff aware of the friendship with the Anthony's?
2 CB He was aware of it yep.
3 CE But not the depth of the friendship?
4 CB No. And not, I don't think that he knew about the money part either.
5 CE Well, does he know now?
6 CB I don't think so.
7 CE Okay, 'cause I know from conversing with her there's some... she seems to be a
8 little reluctant to out with certain things and we're...
9
10 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
11 CEjust trying to establish may why that is.
12 CB Because probably afraid that she's going to lose him.
13 CE Lose Jeff?
14 CB Jeff, right.
15 CE Over the involvement with George?
16 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
17 CE Did she give you specifics, because it appears that she's heartbroken?
18 CB That's where.. that's.. that's where I was.. I was.. I was believing that they had an
19 affair. Like she never came out and said it. But the ... the reactions was
20 everything. Like I couldn't understand why her heart was so broken.
21
22 CE Um, you say you saw George twice at the house. And, and um, have you been
23 to the Anthony's home yourself?
24 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
25 CE Okay. You been there with, with ah, I keep wanting to call her River, but Krystal?

1 CB Krystal yes.

2 CE Okay so you visited the Anthony home with Krystal.

3 CB The day that I got out, the next morning.

4 CE Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

5 CB She took me over there to meet them.

6 CE Did you...

7

8 CB The news crew was there. They weren't home, but we was at um, she called

9 him, she called George and he told her to come ... for us to come back later on.

10 And when we came back later on that's when I met him.

11 CE You got to meet George and Cindy?

12 CB Um, no I think it was just George that I met that day. The following few days I

13 think it's after is when I met, is when I met Cindy.

14 CE You went back over there?

15 CB Um, my sister bought her flowers. There was, there was a reason why she

16 bought flowers. I think it was Mother's Day I'm not sure. But they were left on

17 the um.. No, Cindy.. she called Cindy and asked her if she got the flowers Cindy,

18 said no. And um, it was that the flowers were delivered two days after it was

19 suppose to have been delivered. And when, when she finally got them that's

20 when she called my sister and then we went over there and met them.

21

22 CE Who would be at the home when you would visit. Normally?

23 CB It was just George and her.

24 CE Did you ever visit the home while Casey was there?

25 CB No, I didn't know Casey.

1 CE Other then...

2 CB Before then.

3 CE Okay.

4 CB I didn't know, I didn't know them at all. I only knew them after I came out of the
5 jail is when I knew them.

6 CE Okay. So, you've never seen Casey in her home?

7 CB No.

8 CE Um, You had said that there was one time that you visited the Anthony home by
9 yourself. Can you tell me about that again.

10 CB I went after my sister had broke down crying off of a text that she sent him and
11 he didn't respond to it. I took the cell phone and I sent him a text and it was not a
12 pretty text, but I waited for his response and he didn't. And my sister was hurt
13 and I took the car and went over his house. And Cindy was there George wasn't
14 there.

15 CE And what happened?

16 CB I knocked on the door and told her when she came to the door I told her that she
17 was full of shit her and her family was full of shit. And I didn't appreciate what
18 she did to my sister. And that she was lucky that I couldn't get myself in trouble
19 anymore. She told me get off her property.

20 CE What did.. did you ask her for money back or...

21 CB No.

22 CE ...did you mention the money?

23 CB No, didn't mention any of it.

24

25

1 CM You say you went to the house and then you said that they were full of shit.
2 What's that pertaining to? Why did you go there as opposed to just not answering
3 the text message how's that (Inaudible)...

4 CB Because my sister at that point she was looking for, she was to me she was
5 looking for him to respond to the, to the text. They were supposed to have met,
6 he put her off like twice. And the third time that there was a text he said that he
7 was coming, he was on his way. And um, he gave her some type of lie and
8 found out that he never came to gate, he wasn't there and my sister was furious.
9 That's when I took the text.. that's when I took the phone I sent him a text I sent
10 him a text, I waited for him to say... I.. I specifically wrote something to the effect
11 like, as much as sister did for you this is what.. this is how you repay her you
12 can't even um, you can't even respond to a text that's nice. And he didn't
13 respond to my text, which pissed me off from watching my sister crying. That's
14 why I left and went to her house.

15

16 CM But why would you say they're full of shit as opposed to just why you stand uh,
17 why you standing us up? 'Cause to me that's a little bit different saying
18 someone's full of shit.

19

20 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

21 CM Why that you thought certain things. Just 'cause they don't text you back and not
22 shown up makes it...

23 CB Because she was suppose to be.. he was.. there was.. it was three times that he
24 put my sister off. He put my sister off three times.

25 CM That he stood her up?

1 CB Right, he stood her up three times.
2 CE After this memorial?
3 CB Yes.
4 CE After this service?
5 CB After that.
6 CE Okay, so, let me.. so, we stay on track. This, this um... I know what Yuri's
7 getting at. But I'm gonna show you some images that we downloaded from the
8 phone and they're dated um, 8/9 of 2009.
9
10 CB Okay.
11 CE Um, and if you viewed these imagines they're on page 41 of 78.
12 CB Uh-huh. (Affirmative)
13 CE The first image is, looks it appears to be George speaking on a podium.
14 CB I snapped that shot.
15 CE You did?
16 CB Yeah.
17 CE Okay can you tell me about that as we go down?
18 CB The, the next, the next one is I.. my sister Krystal, River and Anthony I snapped
19 that.
20 CE Image 49?
21 CB I snapped that shot.
22 CE Okay.
23 CB I sat behind them. Them two were crying at this, in this photo them two. He was
24 crying to her. They both were crying and I snapped that shot.
25

1 CE Okay.

2 CB The bottom one um, my sister wanted a picture of all three of us and there was a
3 lady that was there she took the picture of all three of us.

4 CE Tell me about that day. What.. where.. where is that and what is that event?

5 CB Um, this day was a private.. it was only maybe like 30 people, 40 people that
6 were invited to this um, this a balloon gathering for Casey.

7 CE Now there was a, there was some kind of function after that?

8 CB Yes.

9 CE What, what happened there?

10 CB Um, there was, there was um, there was a vigil and they had um, inside the
11 church they, a few people stood up and said something. There was a preacher
12 that was there. Um, after that ceremony we was led outside in the back and
13 there was some balloons that they let out in memory of Case... um...

14 CM Caylee.

15 CB ...Caylee. And um, after that we was all brought into another room where they
16 had cake and um, drinks.

17 CM How long after that would you say was the time when you went and confronted
18 Cindy? Or went to confront George and then confronted Cindy?

19 CB I think, I think it was about a week after that this happened. After I snapped
20 these shots I think it was about week.

21 CM So, in that, in hat week time frame he stood your sister up three times?

22 CB Yep.

23 CE Okay so, if that is 8/9/09.

24

25

1 CB Yeah.

2 CE Okay, 'cause I'm looking at the text on 12/16 of '08 earlier the, the year prior.

3 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

4 CE There's a text message number text number 88 from it says George..

5 CB This was the...

6 CE ...Anthony.

7 CB ...this is the beginning I think this... yeah this was when, this was before this.

8 CE Right.

9 CB This text was before these shots were taken.

10 CE Just thinking about you, I need you...

11 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

12 CE ...in my life.

13 CB Right.

14 CE Okay. Alright, so chronologically then so, to go off what Yuri is saying, this, this

15 friendship's occurring, you're inviting to personal type family functions to

16 include...

17 CB Right.

18 CE ...the memorials and the services and things of that nature.

19 CB Right.

20 CE And George earlier the year prior is saying he needs her in his life.

21 CB Right.

22 CE But now it seems like after this service um...

23 CB That's when everything went down yeah.

24

25

1 CE She's cut out...

2 CB Actually they was um...

3 CE Sorry.

4 CM That's alright.

5 CB I think I'm not sure you guys have to ask my sister, but there was one.. I think

6 that she was supposed to give him some money and she didn't. And I believe

7 that's what led to her and him.. or him not texting her back.

8

9 CE How much money did she say?

10 CB I'm thinking it was four hundred. I'm not sure, but I believe it was four hundred.

11 SA So, are you saying ...

12 CB That was the last one.

13 SA ...the money stopped and then the friendship stopped?

14 CB Yeah that's why I said she was full of shit when I... I said they were full of shit

15 not her. You guys were full of shit. Your family's full of shit.

16 CM Did you ever loan them any money?

17 CB No.

18 CM It was just your sister?

19 CB Yep.

20 CE Where.. and I asked you earlier I apologize. Where did the money come from?

21 CB A varie... vary... her son's father, her boyfriend, her tax. Um, son..

22 CE She had a savings account?

23 CB Um, not sure see I was in jail so I'm not really sure. But um, she does get an

24 allowance and stuff so.

25

1 CE From Jeff?

2 CB From Jeff, she gets money from her son who's 19.. 18 um, he sends her money.
3 The kid's father sends her money and I know that she had like I think it was
4 twenty-three hundred from um, the tax.

5 CE Income tax return?

6 CB Yes. Uh-huh. (affirmative).. There's credit cards that she has where if you want
7 to pull those there's the flowers that were sent. Um...

8 CE You said she'd given Cindy some gifts. What type of gifts were those?

9 CB She bought Cindy um, a pendant a diamond um, piece that goes to her um, to a
10 chain. It was a diamond I think it was ah, something from um, I don't know it was
11 a diamond piece pendant. She got she bought her that and she bought..

12 CE Was she upset about seeing that on television? Did she say anything to you
13 about that? That Cindy had worn that on a particular show?

14 CB I can't remember.

15 CE Okay. What did... did Cindy ever tell you at any time that she was unaware that
16 George was getting money from your sister?

17 CB No, never told me that.

18 CE Cindy didn't tell you that.

19 CB No.

20 CE Okay. Um, want to go into the jail part?

21 SA Before you do that I have one question about this. This cell phone, I look at the
22 cell phone records there's a there's three Georges or there's a George Anthony
23 and a number for George Anthony. Um, looks like it was..

24

25

1 CB One, there's another George.. I.. I play paddle ball.
2 SA Okay.
3 CB And he's my coach so.
4 SA Okay so, so, this George..
5 CB That's George.
6 SAand this is not a number.. another number for George Anthony. It's a different
7 George?
8 CB It's.. it's a J-O-R-G-E?
9 SA No, this is a G-O-R... It's look here, look, look hereon page 6 and correct me...
10 CB It should only... I think there should only be like 2.
11 SA But my question is, do we know if this G-E-O and George and George Anthony
12 are those three different numbers for George Anthony? Or are they three
13 different people? Or do you know the answer?
14 CB No those are three different people.
15 SA Okay thank you.
16 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
17 CE Sky, before we um, I mean me, today.. last night I asked you and your sister
18 mentioned in the interview that the (Inaudible)... that George Anthony had written
19 her letters?
20 CB Yes.
21 CE And you guys brought one to us today. I'll.. I'll get with your sister on this, we'll
22 have her sign a property form. I just want to, this is the letter that your sister
23 delivered us, to us today?
24
25

1 CB Yes.

2 CE Okay and you're gonna maybe go back to the house today and help her find...

3 CB Yeah.

4 CE ... the others?

5 CB Yeah.

6 CE Um, and we can segue into the fact that you yourself may have something

7 that um, Casey had given you while you were in jail?

8

9 CB Yeah, it was ah, um, I think you are the type of... it was um, I have to find it. I'll

10 look for it though. It was a thank you um, letter.

11 CE Okay, Yuri's gonna probably go more into depth about the time that you had

12 spent down there in the jail and got to know her.

13 CM Before we go into the jail there's a couple of questions I wanted to go on what

14 Eric talked about. Did George ever talk to you about the case?

15 CB No.

16 CM Did George ever talk to you and Krystal... or I'm sorry, you and River, you and

17 Krystal...

18 CB Yeah.

19 CM ...about the case like (inaudible) frustration that was or was not being done? Or

20 what he was he was doing that law enforcement wasn't?

21

22 CB I really never held... I mean I've held a conversation with George. But just in ah,

23 it would never have to do... it had nothin'... never to do with the case. I didn't

24 feel close enough to him. But my sister is the one that would know more about

25 that.

1 CM What did your sister tell you about conversations she had with George about this
2 case?
3 CB Um, as far as what I found out last night?
4 CM Well in general...
5 CB Or just...
6 CM ...you know just.. just what did...
7
8 CB I...
9 CM ... what will your sister tell about what she talked about George.
10 CB Well she, she never, she never, you know after that situation... after the last,
11 after I went to the house and stuff that I said. I went back to my sister she was
12 still mad at, I was furious. 'Cause that's when I found out that she had given him
13 all that money. So, I told her at that time I didn't want to speak to her about him
14 anCMore. I don't want to hear anything that has to do with George. Um, and
15 that was it. So, I didn't.. we hadn't said anything to each other until you guys
16 came knocking on the door yesterday.
17 CM And...
18 CB So...
19 CB ... and after we left?
20 CB But.. and so after you left she was in panic mode and kept telling me, um, there's
21 stuff that I know. And I'm like well whatever you need to know you need to talk to
22 the officers. But I said is it him and she didn't say... she was like, no. And I said,
23 it's her? And she didn't say anything. So, I said it is her. And I said I knew it
24 was her.
25

1 CM Her meaning?

2 CB The mother, the.. Cindy.

3 CM Hm.

4 CB And I said, she was like no I can't, I can't say anything. And I said, whatever you,
5 whatever you know this is a child that's the child that's dead you need to talk for
6 her.

7

8 CE It's Cindy or it's Casey?

9 CB I'm sorry.

10 CE You said it's her.

11 CB Meaning the.. Cindy. I was trying to ask her if she knew, if she knew anything
12 and when I said is it him meaning, did he have something to do with it? She told
13 me no. And I said so, it was her, meaning Cindy. And she didn't say anything
14 she just closed up. So, that's when I said whatever you know you need to tell
15 them. And she was worried how you guys found her and, and um, well you know
16 what she told you last night. But um, what I did... she did tell me that he did tell
17 her that um, it was something about an accident. There was a comment that she
18 made I don't know word for word. But she can tell it to you, but she did say
19 something that he said, it's something about an accident. Accident...

20

21 CM Accident a car accident or...

22 CB No the death, the child being killed by accident.

23 CM What, what did she tell you respect to an accident though? What did George
24 say? Did he say he thought it was an accident or he knew it was an accident?
25 What did she tell you? What did Krystal tell you?

1 CB That's what I'm saying she... it was it.. the way she said it she said, oh he said to
2 her um, some.. something about it being an accident. It.. it.. it was.. or flew off
3 the handle and it was an accident, was how she said it.
4 CM And the way she's saying you believe it to be George describing what happened
5 to Caylee the child?
6 CB Yes.
7 CM And how that someone flew off the handle and as a result..
8 CB And it was done.. Right.
9 CM ...Caylee got killed?
10 CB Right.
11 CE And did she describe to you how that may have occurred?
12 CB She didn't tell me, I didn't get too much... I told you I would talk to her last night.
13 CE Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
14 CB She was really tired. This morning we just flew up and we just you know got up.
15 But um, if you guys don't get it from her today I'll grill it out of her and I'll figure
16 and I'll find out.
17 CE What else did she tell you that she knew?
18 CB Um, oh she told me that um, she.. I believe she was either there or she.. he told
19 her about it after it happened when he grabbed I think it was Casey that she
20 grabbed.. that he grabbed by the neck or the mom. I'm, I'm not too sure. Like
21 this case is not really something that I'm. So, when she talks about it I kind of
22 just listen, but the on... so, I.. I don't know if she said the father grabbed Casey
23
24
25

1 or he grabbed the mom by the throat. And I'm not too sure if she said that she
2 was there or he called her after and told her.

3 CE So, she may have been there?

4 CB Yeah I'm not sure you have to ask her.

5 CE Or he...

6 CB I don't know if she was...

7 CEcalled her after the fact that..

8 CB It's one of the two, but I know that she knows about it.

9 CE Okay. Did she say why George grabbed whoever it was that he grabbed?

10 CB Um, she might've I can't.. I can't bring it up I don't... I'm not...

11 CE That's fine.

12 CM Is there anything else that she told you about conversations with George that you
13 can remember now? As far as last night after they left?

14 CB Last night we didn't really, she was just in panic mode and she was just scared.
15 I.. my main thing was trying her... not to have a seizure last night. So, I didn't
16 question her too much. I didn't say anything. The only thing that she did admit to
17 me is that he said to her that something about it being an accident. And she also
18 mentioned to me last night that um, either she was there or he called her after he
19 put his hands on her.

20 CE She was there meaning Krystal was there?

21 CB My sister, yeah either my sister...

22 CB Or he called.

23

24

25

1 CB ...was there at the house when it happened or he called her after and told her
2 what he did.
3 CE Okay. Do you know a Zenaida Gonzalez at all?
4 CB No I don't.
5 CE Did they ever talk about Zenaida Gonzalez at all?
6 CB Yeah.
7 CM To you?
8 CB Well, Krystal has.
9 CM What about George? George in your presence talked about her at all?
10 CB Um...
11 CM About they were dealing to try and find out who this person was?
12 CB You know they was, they was always conversating I just never was.. you know I
13 felt awkward um, that here I was just come out of jail. And to meet the parents of
14 this girl who's murdered her child. So, I really wasn't in all to that. I.. my thing
15 was I was just there to... 'Cause I knew that my sister, I knew that the
16 friendship... I knew about the friendship. So, my.. I was just supporting my
17 sister.
18 CM When you say George would visit. In the times that he visited after you got out of
19 jail said he goes to your house two times. Was he alone or ...
20 CB Yeah he was always alone.
21 CM Ah, was does Jeff Allen live at the house with you guys?
22 CB Yes.
23 CM Okay, was Jeff Allen present at the time?

1 CB Not those times.

2 CM What about the times that you weren't there was.. Krystal says, George came
3 over several times before that.

4 CB Yeah.

5 CM And times after that.

6 CB Hm.

7 CM did Krystal ever tell you who was at the house or was it just she...
8

9 CB It was just...

10 CM ...and George?

11 CB ...always her and him and, and I think Brittney, her daughter was there maybe
12 one or two occasions when she might've just not felt whatever (Inaudible)...
13 But most of the times it was between the hours from 10 o'clock to 2 and that's
14 when Jeff was gone.

15 CE Where would Jeff be?

16 CB At work.

17 CE Dealing with his rental properties or ...

18 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative).. He's got an office... well now it's in Maitland, but it used
19 to be on Lee Road.

20 CE So, he had a set time during the day that he would be gone?

21 CB Yeah he's out of the house everyday no later then 9... He gets up at 8:20 he
22 takes his shower, he lets the dog out and he's out of the house no later the 9:05.
23

24 CM So, he usually works 9 to 5? Banker's hours?

25 CB About 9 he, between 9.. he comes home between 1.. 1 and 1:30.

1 CM I want to go into the jail part. You said you were incarcerated. Do you remember
2 when you were arrested when you went to the Orange County Jail?
3 CB I believe it was August 16th.
4 CM Of 2008?
5 CB Yeah.
6 CM And you left just.. you spent five months you say?
7 CB Yeah,
8 CM Out in January?
9 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
10 CM And do you remember what pod or what cell you were in? What division you
11 were in?
12 CB Yeah I can't it's um...
13 CM Well let's make it easy. Were you in the same cell block as Casey Anthony?
14 The same unit that ...
15 CB Same building?
16 CMCasey..
17 CB On no not the same unit.
18 CM Okay.
19 CB I was a trustee.
20 CM Okay. And in your times of being a trustee you mentioned to us before hand that
21 you I guess got to know Casey or clean her cell?
22 CB Right.

25

1 CM Walk me through that again. I know you already told it once, but ... But how did
2 you become a trustee and how'd you end up ...

3 CB Oh um...

4 CM ...meeting her?

5 CB ...I became.. because um, I didn't want to just sit around the jail and just do
6 nothing for five months. So, I got applied for the trustee job and I got that. And
7 in the beginning um, like I told him. Um, I didn't really like her because I knew
8 what she was there for. So, I was kind of like being, not mean to her , but like
9 lower the eyes and giving her nasty looks and stuff. Um, it was I think two
10 months after me being there I started reading the bible and um, I know you're not
11 supposed to judge anyone. And so, I chose not to judge her and not that I
12 befriended her. I kind of guess I did um, I was trying to be nice to her. I kind of
13 felt bad that all the inmates there were in that building in that one block. Would
14 be screaming murderer um, you know just mean things to her.

15

16 CM Right.

17 CB And I felt like she needed just, just one person that she can just say hello that
18 wouldn't give her a nasty attitude. And I, I.. that's where I became... that's where
19 I came in at.

20

21 CM And what was your roll in, what were you doing in her pod, in her area as a
22 trustee?

23 CB I had to clean the whole block as far as each cell. I had to when she was giving
24 her hour out she would only take a shower and I had to give her uniform while
25 she was in the, in the shower I had to go clean her, her cell.

1 CM Okay, just normal trustee stuff? Nothing...

2 CB Yes.

3 CM ...different then you would normally do as a trustee?

4 CB No. Huh-uh. (Negative)

5 CM And I guess during that time frame you got to speak with her or...

6 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

7 CM ...ah, not a relationship, but you got acquainted ..

8 CB Right.

9 CM ...with her? (inaudible)..

10

11

12 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

13 CM And tell me about that acquaintance.

14 CB Um, I would just ask her if she was alright if she needed anything, how she was

15 doing. Um, we never really, I never really, I never spoke to her about her family.

16 I.. she.. I would just tell her that I seen your parents on TV. And 'cause she

17 wasn't allowed, that block wasn't allowed to have the television on. So, she

18 would ask how her mom and her father would look. And you know I would in

19 return would answer, oh they look fine. Or I seen your brother on TV. Um, just

20 whatever I seen on TV. We really weren't allowed to talk to her, but there were

21 certain officers that I was cool with at that time, that didn't have a problem with

22 me just talking to her. So...

23

24 CM And that's talking through the closed door?

25 CB Yeah. Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

1 CM Okay. When, when you were in he jail getting to talk to Casey. Did you have
2 any idea that your sister was friendly with the Anthony's?
3 CB I had no idea that she....
4 CM Did she call you and let you know that...
5 CB I had no communications with her.
6 CM Okay, so you had no idea that your sister was talking to the Anthony's at the
7 time?
8 CB I had no idea.
9 CM When, did Casey ever ask you to do anything for her while you guys were at the
10 jail?
11 CB Just to pass a letter.
12 CM A letter or letters?
13 CB Two letters I passed for her.
14 CM Okay. And who were these letters from?
15 CB The girls upstairs that was above her.
16 CM What um, you mentioned before there was a girl in your...
17 CB In my dorm there was one in my dorm and two up in her dorm.
18 CM Okay. The girl in your dorm do you remember her name?
19 CB I think her name was Martha. I believe her name was Martha.
20 CM Is she a white girl, black, Hispanic?
21 CB No Spanish.
22 CM Do you know what she was in for?
23 CB Murder.
24
25

1 CM The one in your dorm was?

2 CB Yeah.

3 CM Okay. And what about the other two girls that were in her dorm? Do you
4 remember?

5 CB I.. I.. I remember them because I..

6 CM Were they in jail...

7 CB ...asked 'em um...

8 CMwhat they were in for?

9 CB I think one, one was came out I believe it came out was like a butch whatever,
10 gay whatever. She looked like a boy.

11 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

12 CB It showed a picture I know about yeah.

13 CM And how many notes would you say you passed from the girl that was in your
14 dorm to Casey?

15 CB I did that twice in my dorm.

16 CM From your dorm to Casey?

17 CB Right. Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

18 CM And how about...

19 CB And there was a clipping, I sent too her.. well that I, I gave to her.
20

21 CM Newspaper?

22 CB A clipping, yeah of a news clipping.

23 CM Well do you remember what it was about? I know it's kind of hard but...

24 CB Um, the Anthony case.
25

1 CM Okay. And that was from the girl in the other dorm? The one in your dorm?
2 CB My dorm. Right.
3 CM To her. And the ones that were in... so two notes from that one to Casey. What
4 about the ones that were in her dorm? Do you remember how many notes back
5 and forth?
6 CB No I think that ah, I'm gonna just say maybe three or four times I did that.
7 CM Okay. From them to Casey. What about from Casey to them?
8 CB Um, from Casey to them was twice.
9 CM Okay. What...
10 CB And the girls I think maybe two or three times upstairs.
11 CM So, two from Casey about two to three from the people up top?
12 CB Right.
13 CM What about one of the other dorm? How many times did she send letters in?
14 CB Ah, we.. I did that... well, it was once on her behalf and once on my behalf.
15 CM Okay, so Martha or the one from your dorm sent one, then you sent one.
16 CB Then I sent one.
17 CM And yours was, what?
18 CB A card um, it was a Christmas that one of the girls drew something and it was
19 just um, like a feel better kind of little drawing. And in return um, she tried to give
20 me, she tried to pass me one. But they had commissary that day and I couldn't
21 get it. So, I had to wait till the next following morning to get it. But she sent me a
22 um, a letter, which I told him I would try to get it. I'm almost sure I have it 'cause
23 I, that took everything. I have not been in that bag since I came out of the jail.
24
25

1 But I, I'll give it to you it's something like thank you for being there. In fact there's
2 um, on the TV one of the things um, she's on there talking to her parents. And
3 she's saying, well I met a girl who's here and she's very nice. And she's about
4 the only one that I talk to.

5 CE That..

6 CB That was me.

7
8 CM The.. how would you pass notes to her?

9 CB Um...

10 CM You're not gonna get in trouble for telling...

11 CB ...I was...

12 CM ...us.

13 CB Okay. Um, I would when I was sweeping all the letters would be rolled up like
14 um, you know just rolled up.

15 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

16 CB And um, the girls sometimes would tie it real tight and I would put it on the floor
17 when I get next to her cell I'd slid it under her door.

18 CM And how would she get letters to you?

19 CB Um, when I would pass her um, her meals she, you know would pass it through
20 the little cubby hole thing. And when I'd give it to her she'd give it to me and I'd
21 put it in my sleeve.

22
23 CM Okay. Did she ever give you anything other then letters?

24 CB No.

25 CM Were you ever told to bring her anything other then letters?

1 CB No just ah, letters the clipping and the card that I send.

2 CM Did anyone from the outside of the jail tell I'll give you something, say hey give
3 this to Casey?

4 CB Never.

5 CM Did anyone inside the jail aside from the three in.. and other inmates you talked
6 about ever tell you hey, give this to Casey?

7 CB Um, no. Huh-uh. (Negative)

8 CM Any corrections officer ever state anything like that?

9 CB No. Never.

10 CM Okay. As far as CO's are concerned they, they, they didn't tell you go
11 communicate with her? Go pass ...

12 CB Oh no..

13 CM ...these to her?

14 CB ...we weren't.. like they was certain, there was like this one officer who was just
15 strict. So, when she was there Ms. Cox, I didn't play with her.

16 CM Okay.

17 CB But the other ones that I became cool with Ms. Hall I think her name was Ms.
18 Hall. There's Ms. Rivera and there's another dark skin officer I don't remember
19 her name. But um, they were cool so and I was there for a long time.

20 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

21 CB So, they just... they would eye me but you know just not really eye me.

22 CM They would.. they wouldn't be on top of you?

23 CB No.

24

25

1 CM Get away with giving her the notes?
2 CB Yeah.
3 CM I want to show you pictures I just want you to tell me if these people look familiar
4 to you at all.
5 CB Okay.
6 CM By all means I'm not saying that you know them or don't.
7
8 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
9 CM But if they do I'd like you to tell me if you do.
10 CB (showing photo of Maya Derkovic) I don't know 'em.
11 CM No?
12 CB Huh-uh. (Negative)
13 CM Okay, give that back.
14 CB (showing photo of Robyn Adams) She kind of looks familiar but... I don't... She
15 was in the jail?
16 CM I'm just asking if you know her.
17 CB I don't know her face kind of looks familiar, but she was not standing out to me.
18 CM Okay. So, the only note that you have, you may have that thank you note you
19 said you have that for us?
20
21 CB Yep.
22 CM Do you know, did Casey tell you or do you know of anyone in the jail that she
23 was actually friends with that may have been communicating with her?
24 CB There was a sergeant like I was telling the detective, there was a sergeant that
25 would come every morning. And he was um, he used to come every morning at 8

1 o'clock. I have to be there at 8, so he would come like 8, between 8:30 and 9
2 o'clock. He would walk with the nurse and the psychiatrist and he was always
3 knocking on doors to make sure...
4 SA Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
5 CB ...that you[re alive and if you need anything, you need your medicine or
6 whatever. This one, this one particular he was a sergeant he would always pop
7 her gate and he would just conversate with her.
8
9 CM Uh-h
10 SA Pop her gate you mean...
11 CB Open her, open her cell.
12 SA I got you. Okay.
13 CM You have your computer up here?
14 CE Ah, over on my desk.
15 SA What do you need?
16 CE A David photo.
17 SA Of?
18 CM The two girls, or one of the girls.
19 SA Which one? You mean write down the information and I'll go. I get somebody
20 to...
21
22 CM I'm trying get you a better photo of one 'em.
23 CB Okay.
24 CM Here you go.
25 SA Okay.

1 CM Thanks Sarge.

2 SA Okay.

3 (Sergeant Allen left to get photograph to show Cecelia)

4 CE Gonna be a question... oh go ahead and stop the flow on the jail part.

5 CM Now (Inaudible)... Did Casey ever talk to you about the case?

6 CB Never.

7 CM She..

8 CB Oh well no she.. she would ask um, how just how her parents was. Um, if I've

9 seen them on TV. Um, um, nothing about the child though.

10

11 CM She share ah, talk to you about being aggravated? Um...

12 CB Oh yeah she was always just pissed off. She was..

13 CM About what?

14 CB About her being in there. She didn't want to be in there.

15 CM Okay. Was she taking it hard or was she kind of light about it or..

16 CB Um, in the beginning she was hard with it. Um, towards my, towards the end of

17 my.. my stay there she was just sleeping a lot like all day.

18 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

19 CB Like she.. I.. I'm the one that breakfast, lunch and dinner I brought over to them.

20 And I couldn't leave until I was there from 9.. from 8 o'clock to 6 o'clock. So, I

21 couldn't leave until after, after 6 everyday. This was everyday like Monday

22 through Sunday I never got a day off. But um, towards the end she was just

23 sleeping a lot.

24

25 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

1 CB Um, I'm assuming that she was on some type of medicine 'cause the nurse
2 would come over.

3 CM Did she ever, she ever simply told you A, the cops are doing something wrong.
4 Or I would do this? Did she ever talk about Caylee at all?

5 CB She just said that she, she wasn't.. she didn't have... she wasn't Huh. She just
6 said that she shouldn't be in there is what she said. She didn't want to be in
7 there.

8 CM I don't think anyone really wants to...

9 CB Yeah.

10 CM ...be in jail. But ah, so aside from that any other conversations as far as what
11 she would be doing if she were out? She would go and look for Casey?
12

13 CB Um, no.

14 CM Or Caylee.

15 CB Nope. Huh-uh. (Negative) Nothing like that. I did tell her that they did have her
16 on TV with um, something about her taking some type of co... some cocaine of
17 some pictures about it. And she laughed at that so.

18 CM She laughed at it?

19 CB Yeah.

20 CM Did, well you were obviously there after the body was found. The body was
21 found back in December.
22

23 CB Yeah.

24 CM Middle of December.

25 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

1 CM Did you, you were still bring her food after that?

2 CB Yeah I delivered the food.

3 CM Did her attitude change after that, after the body was found?

4 CB Yeah it um...

5 CM How would you describe it?

6 CB Just... I don't know like one moment she would be um, fine like how my sister

7 was yesterday. One moment she would be fine. And ten the next moment she'd

8 just be stuck on space. Like she just be spaced out. She wouldn't.. she just, she

9 was literally just sit in her cell and just stare at the wall. She had these two, two

10 pictures of Cay.. Casey on her...

11

12 CM Of Caylee?

13 CB Of Caylee of her, the baby. Of, on her.. it was like um, something that was just

14 photocopied. And um, maybe somebody sent her. Oh she did tell me about

15 money being sent to her.

16 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

17 CB From different people.

18 CM Did she ever tell you about her attorney? She was pleased with her attorney or

19 had any issues?

20 CB I had no, never said anything about that.

21 CM Never talked about it.

22 CB Nope. Huh-uh. (Negative) Huh-uh. (Negative)

23 CM She ah, complaining say anything about her parent?

24

25

1 CB Not to me. Never to me. She just asked um, I told her I did see the parents on
2 TV. She did ask me how they looked. I told her..

3 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

4 CB ...they look fine.

5 CM What about after you got out of jail and you need up meeting the Anthony's. Did
6 they... obviously learned that you were in jail with their daughter.

7 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

8 CM What was their reaction? Did they kind of pump you for information asking you
9 how she was doing? Or...

10 CB Um, my sister didn't want it. She didn't want me to talk to them. She didn't want
11 me to tell them. 'Cause me and my sister different, I don't care, my sister does.
12 And she didn't want me to say anything to him about, about um, anything bad
13 about her. I really never didn't have anything bad to say. But as far as I did tell
14 him that, I did know your daughter inside. And I'm the one that she's the one that
15 was talking about when.. he asked me if I treated her fine. I said I never not you
16 know didn't ever treat her bad.

17 CM And this is Cindy and George you're talking about?

18 CB No George. And I was in the process of telling her.. him that um, how the girls
19 were treating her and my sister stopped me and told me that he couldn't handle
20 that for me not to say anything.

21 CM What was his reaction? Did he pump you for in... If I hadn't seen my daughter.

22 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

23 CM In 6 months.

1 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

2 CM And you got out in January. So, we're talking January, February now.

3 CB Right.

4 CM She was in jail since October without any visits. I would be asking a lot of
5 questions. How's she doing, how's she look, how she eating.

6 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

7 CM And all that. Did George ask you any of that?

8 CB No he didn't ask of it. He didn't ask me.

9 CM So, you were the directing action to her daughter?

10 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

11 CM To their daughter?

12 CB Right.

13 CM And...

14 CB My sister hid a lot of it. I don't know what my sister told him. But I know when,
15 when me and my sister talked about it. Um, she told me not to say, she
16 specifically told me, George couldn't handle it. Do not say, do not tell them you
17 know about how the girls was treating him.. I mean treating you know the girls in
18 the cell they would yell murderer, you child killer. He.. my sister told me not to
19 tell him that because he couldn't handle it.

20

21

22 CE Hm.

23 CM But he never asked?

24 CB Never.

25

1 CM Regardless what your sister would say. He could've asked right there's was
2 opportunities there he could..

3 CB Yeah.

4 VCM ...said, well you saw her today tell me how she's doing?

5 CB I told him she was fine that's it.

6 CM And he never pulled you aside or tried to pull you aside or...

7 CB No because the attitude I had towards him. I had an attitude towards them
8 anyway. Because I from the beginning already knew they full of shit.

9 CE What was Cindy's attitude when she saw your sister with George? How did she
10 respond to that?

11 CB She to me always was eyeing my sister anytime them two were together she
12 would eye them. So, I don't know if there was a trust thing with.. I.. I don't know
13 what the extent of what she knew. But I don't think she knew all the times that he
14 came or he was corresponding with my sister.

15 CM Did you ever have cause to talk to her about Casey and get the same question
16 with George? Did Case.. she ever... did Cindy know you were in jail with Casey?

17 CB Yeah she knew it.

18 CM So, after you were out you had a opportunity to be with Cindy.

19 CB Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

20 CM Did she ever pull you aside and ask how her daughter was doing? How she's
21 feeling?

22 CB No because I.. I gave them, I gave really here and him sometimes attitude. Like
23 it...

24
25

1 CM Right off the bat?

2 CB Yeah. Right off.

3 CM They still didn't try to approach you and say listen.

4 CB No because I believe my sister...

5 CM Regardless of what you think.

6 CB Because when I.. I.. my sister told me... we're not the same. And she's not, my

7 sister's not, her telling them, my sister is not gonna she's not, she's not like me.

8

9 CM Did George or Cindy ever ask your sister to do something ah, to make anything

10 up. Make up a web page ah, to help them with anything in this case aside from

11 getting money?

12 CB Not that I know of.

13 CM So, she never, she wouldn't, she never showed any concerned to you about

14 "hey, they asked me to write this on a web page or start a web page or write

15 these letters pretend I'm someone else?" Anything like that..

16 CB No, Krystal.. I mean if anything was mentioned Krystal would always be like, oh

17 I'll do it. You know or like with the buttons or the shirts and stuff.

18

19 CM Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

20 CB It was always if it was mentioned my sister would be like, okay I'll do it.

21 CM Okay. I'm gonna show you another picture. This is a picture of one the people I

22 showed you. I want to make that clear. But tell me if that looks.. 'cause that was

23 the one that you said may look familiar, but you're not sure.

24 CB (showing DAVID photo of Robyn Adams) Yeah she does look familiar I just don't

25 know where I know her from.

1 CM That's okay. You mean you may or may not know it because the picture that I
2 showed you obviously is different then that. I wanted to make sure that you saw
3 her ..

4 CB I just...

5 CM ...in two different lights.

6 CB I don't know where and her face is familiar I just, I don't know where I know her
7 from though.

8 CM That's fine.

9 CB I didn't... think it was the jail though.

10 CM Okay that's fine.

11 CB I'm not sure.

12 CM Like I said I wanted to just throw the pictures out and see if you recognize these
13 people. I got nothing else.

14 CE You raise your right hand. Swear that everything you said today is true?

15 CB Yes.

16 CE Freely given?

17 CB Yes.

18 CE it is ah, approximately 11:34 A.M. Thank you.
