5 **JA – SERGEANT JOHN ALLEN**

6 **SB – AGENT SCOTT BOLIN**

7 **JW – MS. JOY WRAY**

8 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative). Alright, Joy, we're going to talk a little bit about this.

9 **JW:** Okay.

10 **JA:** And uh, we'll, we'll probably get a written statement from you. I want to know,  
11 okay, you, let's kind of start from the beginning. You, you brought these pictures  
12 here. You met with the deputies down there, right?

13 **JW:** Yes.

14 **JA:** Okay, and you told them that you were uh, you were taking them to the  
15 Anthony's?

16 **JW:** I was going to go show to them; see if they would like them.

17 **JA:** Okay. So then you went and you went to the Anthony's?

18 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

19 **JA:** Okay.

20 **JW:** Then I came here.

21 **JA:** Okay, what happened while you were in the Anthony's?

22 **JW:** I uhm, Michelle came to the door and I talked to her and I showed them to her.

23 **JA:** Michelle who?

24 **JW:** Michelle Bart.

25 **JA:** Okay.

1 **JW:** And she came to the door and I talked to her a few minutes. She looked at them  
2 and she didn't take them. And so I said, "I guess I can go give them to Baez."  
3 **JA:** Okay.  
4 **JW:** Or and I want to give a copy to you guys.  
5 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
6 **JW:** And so that's what I'm doing.  
7 **JA:** Okay, so you, you brought him here....  
8 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
9 **JA:** Then you talked to the deputies, right?  
10 **JW:** Yes sir.  
11 **JA:** And what did you say to the deputies? Uh, when I go ask the deputies what you  
12 said what are they going to tell me you said do you think?  
13 **JW:** I said, "I took pictures down here from the searches what, when we were...  
14 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
15 **JW:** ...I was uh, with Equisearch and we took uh, me and my husband took pictures.  
16 We went on all the searches and we took pictures of all the searches."  
17 **JA:** Okay.  
18 **JW:** The landfill, we were at the landfill. We were at uhm, I can't remember all of  
19 them. We were at so many. Uhm, the park with Tim Miller. He was in my boat.  
20 **JA:** Okay.  
21 **JW:** Lake Moss Park. Then here. Then we came here a few times.  
22 **JA:** Okay...  
23 **JW:** Just....  
24 **JA:** ...you came here a few times with Equisearch?  
25 **JW:** With, one time with Equisearch.

1 **JA:** Okay.

2 **JW:** Two times just...one time myself and one time with my husband and I.

3 **JA:** I see, okay. (Coughs.) Now you, you uh, you, today. Let's, let's start with today.

4 **JW:** Okay.

5 **JA:** You, you came here. You said something. What, what did you say to the

6 deputies?

7 **JW:** "I have some pictures..."

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** ...that was taken there."

10 **JA:** Taken there, where?

11 **JW:** By the fence.

12 **JA:** By the fence right her?

13 **JW:** Yes sir.

14 **JA:** Okay.

15 **JW:** A few months ago.

16 **JA:** Alright. So you took these pictures by the fence a few months ago, alright. How

17 close to the fence?

18 **JW:** Uhm, probably about...

19 **JA:** Was it like five....

20 **JW:** ...thirty feet.

21 **JA:** Like thirty feet?

22 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

23 **JA:** Okay, I see. Alright. Okay, so if where we're searching is only about five feet it

24 wouldn't be the same, right?

25 **JW:** Exactly.

1 **JA:** Okay. Alright. And if it's about sixty feet it wouldn't be the same, right?  
2 **JW:** Exactly.  
3 **JA:** Alright.  
4 **JW:** I'm just trying to help.  
5 **JA:** And, and I understand that. I understand you're trying to help.  
6 **JW:** You're just scaring me.  
7 **JA:** How am I scaring you? I'm just asking....  
8 **JW:** I don't know, I....  
9 **JA:** Oh.  
10 **JW:** ....just something from the news and stuff.  
11 **JA:** Alright.  
12 **JW:** You just seem like a very....  
13 **JA:** From the news I seem what?  
14 **JW:** Just very hard.  
15 **JA:** Okay, well if, if I'm a....if I ask you a question you don't like tell me you don't like  
16 the question...  
17 **JW:** Okay.  
18 **JA:** ...alright? But I know you want to help, so you want to answer our questions,  
19 right? Yes, you do?  
20 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
21 **JA:** Okay, great, alright.  
22 **JW:** Sorry.  
23 **JA:** Oh, no problem. Alright. Okay, so now (sighs), you took the pictures down there  
24 to the Anthony's?  
25 **JW:** (Inaudible.)

1 **JA:** Did you get to see George or Cindy?  
2 **JW:** Huh-huh (negative).  
3 **JA:** No? Okay. Alright. And then, and then you brought them back here? Okay.  
4 **JW:** Yes.  
5 **JA:** Let's talk about the pictures just real quick here and then go, and go through  
6 them real quick. Uh, here's a picture of uh....  
7 **JW:** Padilla.  
8 **JA:** L...Leonard Padilla?  
9 **JW:** Yes sir.  
10 **JA:** Okay, when did you take that picture?  
11 **JW:** When he first came down there when Tim Miller was out there on my blue boat  
12 with the sonardic system.  
13 **JA:** Leonard was on your blue boat?  
14 **JW:** No, Tim Miller and....  
15 **JA:** Okay.  
16 **JW:** ....his wife.  
17 **JA:** Okay. Now I'm talking about this picture right here. It looks like you got a, it  
18 looks like you have a series of pictures here....  
19 **JW:** Yes.  
20 **JA:** ...that were taken with Leonard, uh, while, when Leonard was here searching  
21 Blanchard Park.  
22 **JW:** Right.  
23 **JA:** Okay? Uh, uh, and we'll, we're going to go through them and look at them a little  
24 bit.  
25 **JW:** And I got them developed the same day.

1 **JA:** Okay, that, that's fine.

2 **JW:** I (inaudible) my memory on the same day.

3 **JA:** Alright, and I want to, I want to, I want to make sure that we get them all right.

4 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative).

5 **JA:** And get, we get in the right places, okay? Uh, you have a picture here uh, was  
6 this picture here, this picture's not at Blanchard Park, is it?

7 **JW:** No. That's uh, yes, that's the tree....

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** ...that he was sitting on the beach. (Unintelligible.)

10 **JA:** I see. Okay. And so let's go through these pictures....

11 **JW:** Okay.

12 **JA:** ...that you took at Blanchard Park with Leonard, okay? You took a picture of this  
13 tree.

14 **JW:** And I dug that up for him.

15 **JA:** Dug what up for who?

16 **JW:** Leonard and Tim Miller. We dug that up, my husband and I did.

17 **JA:** And now what you dug it for Leonard or you dug it for Tim?

18 **JW:** Tim Miller.

19 **JA:** When did you dig that up?

20 **JW:** Uhm, when they were out there.

21 **JA:** When you were out there taking...

22 **JW:** Well...

23 **JA:** ....pictures of Leonard, or when you were out there some other time.

24 **JW:** Searching and taking pictures.

25

1 **JA:** Okay. So you took this picture. You take this picture when, when uh, you were  
2 out there with Tim Miller?  
3 **JW:** Yes.  
4 **JA:** Okay. Alright, so you took this picture when you were with Tim, searching and  
5 uh,....  
6 **JW:** After he got off of my boat.  
7 **JA:** Okay, and where, and what park is this?  
8 **JW:** Blanchard Park.  
9 **JA:** Okay. Alright. (Coughs.) Now you got a picture here of Leonard uh, sitting in  
10 the back of a silver van....  
11 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
12 **JA:** ...talking on the phone, right?  
13 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
14 **JA:** When was that picture taken?  
15 **JW:** The same day.  
16 **JA:** The same day you took the picture of the tree?  
17 **JW:** Yes sir.  
18 **JA:** Which would have been while you were out there with Equisearch?  
19 **JW:** (Unintelligible.) Yes sir.  
20 **JA:** Okay. Now you got....  
21 **JW:** That's spider.  
22 **JA:** Okay, now this is spider. You took this picture when?  
23 **JW:** The same day.  
24 **JA:** When you were out there with?  
25 **JW:** With Tim.

1 **JA:** With Tim? With Equisearch?  
2 **JW:** Yes sir.  
3 **JA:** Okay. Alright, what about this, now this....  
4 **JW:** The same thing.  
5 **JA:** ...and, and this is a picture of some divers in the water, right?  
6 **JW:** Yes sir.  
7 **JA:** Okay.  
8 **JW:** When it's, not the day when they found those toys or the chicken bones.  
9 **JA:** Right. This is a different day?  
10 **JW:** It was the same day with Tim.  
11 **JA:** Okay. Now this picture here is another picture of some divers and people  
12 standing around....  
13 **JW:** That's not...  
14 **JA:** ....the back of a truck.  
15 **JW:** ...the same day. That's a....  
16 **JA:** Okay.  
17 **JW:** ...other day when after they found the chicken bones.  
18 **JA:** Okay, this is the day they found the chicken bones?  
19 **JW:** I'm not a hundred percent sure. The...  
20 **JA:** Okay.  
21 **JW:** ....day of or the next day.  
22 **JA:** Okay. But this is when, you were not out there with Equisearch then?  
23 **JW:** No.  
24 **JA:** You just went down there to see what Leonard was doing?  
25 **JW:** Exactly.

1 **JA:** Okay. So we have pictures from two different days. Now what about this picture  
2 here of Leonard standing by all the news trucks?  
3 **JW:** That was uhm, the day with Tim Miller.  
4 **JA:** Okay, so this, this, the, the, the, are these pictures here, the picture of Leonard  
5 standing by the fence...  
6 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
7 **JA:** ...the picture of the tree where, where, where the beads were found....  
8 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
9 **JA:** ...the picture of Leonard sitting in the back of the truck, or the back of the van....  
10 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
11 **JA:** ...the picture of the diver standing in the water, these were all taken the day you  
12 were out there with Equisearch?  
13 **JW:** Yes sir.  
14 **JA:** Okay. Alright. Now, this other picture, okay, you have a picture of, of a, a diver.  
15 **JW:** He's right about in there.  
16 **JA:** Okay.  
17 **JW:** And the, the bodyguard.  
18 **JA:** Uh, Leonard and the bodyguard are standing in the background. Uh, there's a  
19 truck with some water uh, by it and some food on the, it looks like on the tailgate  
20 of a truck.  
21 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
22 **JA:** But you went out there the day that Leonard found the toys and the beads out  
23 there in the rocks?  
24 **JW:** Yes.  
25 **JA:** Okay. Uh, and you took this picture that day?

1 **JW:** Yes.

2 **JA:** Okay. Did Leonard show you the rocks, or the toys, or the beads?

3 **JW:** No, I didn't get a picture....

4 **JA:** Okay.

5 **JW:** ...of it. I didn't want a picture of that.

6 **JA:** No, no, did you ever see them?

7 **JW:** Uh, far away.

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** I was far away. I couldn't really get a good....

10 **JA:** Alright.

11 **JW:** ....eye of them.

12 **JA:** Okay. What....

13 **JW:** I was about six hundred...

14 **JA:** Okay.

15 **JW:** ....feet away.

16 **JA:** What was, what were they doing with the toys and the rocks and the beads when

17 you saw them?

18 **JW:** They just pulled them out.

19 **JA:** Okay.

20 **JW:** And they were under a rock and they just pulled them out of the water and....

21 **JA:** Who, who's they?

22 **JW:** That guy with the bald head.

23 **JA:** Okay.

24 **JW:** And he, he's the one who found them black divers I think it was called.

25 **JA:** Blackwater Divers?

1 **JW:** Yes sir.

2 **JA:** Okay. So they were still in the water when you saw them?

3 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

4 **JA:** Okay, could you see they were rocks?

5 **JW:** No, I couldn't not see. It was too far.

6 **JA:** Uh, you didn't get....

7 **JW:** No.

8 **JA:** You didn't get close (unintelligible).

9 **JW:** The water's too mucky.

10 **JA:** Okay. Could you see their, uh, did you, did you see that it was a, the toy? Uh,

11 that, you didn't see at that time that they were rocks and....

12 **JW:** Huh-huh (negative).

13 **JA:** ....toys and stuff, right?

14 **JW:** No.

15 **JA:** Okay. Did you ever see them?

16 **JW:** No.

17 **JA:** Okay, how do you, how...

18 **JW:** Far away.

19 **JA:** Okay, let me ask you how you, how you know, how do you know they're, that

20 they're, that they were rocks and toys and stuff?

21 **JW:** Because it's what they said.

22 **JA:** That's what who said?

23 **JW:** Leonard.

24 **JA:** Leonard said that?

25 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

1 **JA:** Okay. Leonard say there were any skeletons in there, or any bones or anything?  
2 **JW:** He said there were uhm, bones.  
3 **JA:** Oh, okay. Did he say they were human bones?  
4 **JW:** I don't remember....  
5 **JA:** Okay.  
6 **JW:** ...to be honest with you.  
7 **JA:** Alrighty, okay. Alright, so we got these pictures that were taken with Equisearch.  
8 And then of course, this one single photo that was taken when you went out  
9 there the day that Leonard found the rocks and the toys and stuff.  
10 **JW:** Yes.  
11 **JA:** Okay. Alright, now we also have a picture here. Let's see. We have a picture  
12 here. It looks like a, a small stream or a creek.  
13 **JW:** That a uhm, you know the path across from the uhm, uhm, the tree and the trail  
14 back there?  
15 **JA:** In Blanchard Park?  
16 **JW:** Yes.  
17 **JA:** Okay.  
18 **JW:** That's from there.  
19 **JA:** Alright, this will be the same tree that where L....Leonard talks about the beads  
20 and all, right?  
21 **JW:** No. This isn't....  
22 **JA:** Different....  
23 **JW:** This isn't....  
24 **JA:** Different part?  
25 **JW:** Where the sewer is. There's a sewer park there.

1 **JA:** Okay.

2 **JW:** Now uh, there's houses right behind....

3 **JA:** Right.

4 **JW:** ...this (unintelligible).

5 **JA:** Okay, you said you or a minute ago you said, a moment ago you said something  
6 about the tree. Is this....

7 **JW:** A tree. It's uhm, on the other side of the uhm, Econ...

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** River.

10 **JA:** Okay, now this, but this is another picture out there at Blanchard Park?

11 **JW:** Yes.

12 **JA:** Okay. Alright, well let me ask you what prompted you to take this photograph?  
13 What was it, what did you think was important about this creek?

14 **JW:** Because it connects the wa...the water to the water that runs on out there. I just  
15 wanted to see how the wa...how the water flows.

16 **JA:** And what did you think was important about that?

17 **JW:** To see if her body could have been in the sewer.

18 **JA:** To see if her body could have been in the sewer?

19 **JW:** And I've researched....

20 **JA:** Did you have some reason...okay, did you think there was, did you have some  
21 reason to think her body was in the sewer?

22 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative). It could have been anywhere.

23 **JA:** Right. And, and uh, I think that's kind of, uh, I think you said it right there. I think,  
24 I think you uh, the point you're making there that she could have been anywhere,  
25 that's what made this so difficult. She could have.....

1 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

2 **JA:** ...been anywhere, okay? Uhm, alright now this picture that you took of uh, uh, of  
3 the day that you went out there that day they found the rocks and the toys, what,  
4 what did you think was important about that? What prompted you to take that  
5 photograph?

6 **JW:** Because to be honest with you....

7 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

8 **JW:** ...I think he was making a show and planting stuff.

9 **JA:** You think Leonard was making a show and planting stuff.

10 **JW:** That's my opinion.

11 **JA:** Okay. And I understand. And that, then, then that, then that's fine. That's, that's  
12 fair. Okay. Uhm, now you have a picture of Leonard standing by the fence.  
13 Uh.....

14 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

15 **JA:** ...what, what, what do you think was important about that?

16 **JW:** I'll probably get in trouble if I say. He's, I felt like he's a media....

17 **JA:** You can say it.

18 **JW:** I don't want to 'cuss. Whore.

19 **JA:** Okay. And that, and that's, and that's....

20 **JW:** Excuse my language.

21 **JA:** Okay. Uh, don't....

22 **JW:** I don't 'cuss.

23 **JA:** I've heard....

24 **SB:** Nope (negative), you're not going to offend anybody.

25 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative).

1 **JW:** Okay.

2 **JA:** We've all heard bad words before, okay? The, the picture of the tree, okay?

3 **JW:** Tree and beads.

4 **JA:** Okay, well let me ask you what you thought was important about the tree?

5 **JW:** Because they uhm, I dug there and they said they found beads and a cross

6 there.

7 **JA:** Who said that?

8 **JW:** Padilla.

9 **JA:** Okay, Padilla, okay. And you felt that was significant because?

10 **JW:** He said that the body was there.

11 **JA:** He said the body was there?

12 **JW:** Between there and uhm....

13 **JA:** Right.

14 **JW:** ...and the picnic tables and the water.

15 **JA:** Leonard said the body, L...Leonard said...

16 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative).

17 **JA:** ...the body was there?

18 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative).

19 **JA:** Okay. Alright. And then of course you have pictures from divers in the water

20 and....

21 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

22 **JA:** ...and pictures of Leonard in the back of the van.

23 **JW:** Correct.

24 **JA:** When you took those, what prompt uh, what, what, what prompted you to take

25 those?

1 **JW:** I just, this was the first day they went in the water.  
2 **JA:** Okay.  
3 **JW:** Spyder did.  
4 **JA:** Alright, okay. Alright, uhm, (sighs), now we have a picture, uh, you said, earlier I  
5 thought you said this was your daughter, okay?  
6 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative), that's Abigail.  
7 **JA:** That's Abigail, your daughter, and that's George, right?  
8 **JW:** Yes.  
9 **JA:** And uh, where did you have this picture of Abigail and George taken together?  
10 **JW:** Eastside Baptist Church.  
11 **JA:** Eastside Baptist Church? Uh....  
12 **JW:** Off of Conway...  
13 **JA:** Okay. Alright, and....  
14 **JW:** ...Gardens Road.  
15 **JA:** Conway Gardens Road. Okay. And what were you guys doing there?  
16 **JW:** Going to the vigils.  
17 **JA:** Going to vigils, okay. And uh, George is smiling. Your, your....  
18 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
19 **JA:** ...your daughter seems like she's smiling.  
20 **JW:** They'd gotten pretty close those two.  
21 **JA:** What, your daughter and George have gotten close?  
22 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
23 **JA:** Oh, that's (inaudible), okay.  
24 **JW:** But I'm not leaving her alone with him.  
25 **JA:** You're not leaving her alone with him?

1 **JW:** No (chuckles).  
2 **JA:** Okay.  
3 **JW:** I don't want my kid to go missing.  
4 **JA:** I know. Okay, well....  
5 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
6 **JA:** ...alright. But uh, you spent, and obviously you spent, if you're, if, if she's gotten  
7 close to George....  
8 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).  
9 **JA:** You've gotten pretty close to the family?  
10 **JW:** Kind of.  
11 **JA:** Kind of close?  
12 **JW:** I don't know all their secrets.  
13 **JA:** Well I'm not asking if you know secrets.  
14 **JW:** Right.  
15 **JA:** I mean obviously your....  
16 **JW:** I talk to them.  
17 **JA:** ...your daughter knows them.  
18 **JW:** I e-mail them.  
19 **JA:** You e-mail them? Okay. Alright.  
20 **JW:** And we talk on the phone.  
21 **JA:** You're friendly with them?  
22 **JW:** Yes.  
23 **JA:** Would that be accurate? Okay. Alrighty. And here's another uh, uh, here's  
24 another photograph here you've taken of uh, where was this taken, "Caylee is  
25 alive," where, where was that taken?

1 **JW:** Somebody took that of, of me holding a sign.

2 **JA:** Alright, somebody, this is a picture of you holding a sign? I guess uh, you can  
3 be, uh, no, uh, it doesn't look like you can be seen in the picture.

4 **JW:** Right.

5 **JA:** But....

6 **JW:** I just took a picture.

7 **JA:** Okay.

8 **JW:** That's my hands.

9 **JA:** I see. Okay.

10 **JW:** Fingers.

11 **JA:** "Caylee is alive." And where were you holding this picture?

12 **JW:** At the memorial. When they did that memorial for Caylee.

13 **JA:** When who did the memorial for Caylee?

14 **JW:** Padilla.

15 **JA:** Okay. So you were, you were....

16 **JW:** And that, that caused, like that made us very upset. He had no right to do that.  
17 That's not his position.

18 **JA:** Okay, so....

19 **JW:** He, at first he called it a funeral.

20 **JA:** Now I understand. Uh, okay. So you were at that memorial service that Leonard  
21 Padilla had and you were holding a sign that said, "Caylee's alive?"

22 **JW:** Yes.

23 **JA:** And then somebody took a picture of you holding that sign?

24 **JW:** Yes.

25 **JA:** Okay. Who were you at that memorial with holding the sign?

1 **JW:** Myself.

2 **JA:** Yourself? Okay, you're, you're the only one there?

3 **JW:** Yes.

4 **JA:** There's nobody else there? Uh, uh....

5 **JW:** There's lots of people but...

6 **JA:** I see, okay.

7 **JW:** But I was the only supporter.

8 **JA:** You were the only supporter? Okay.

9 **JW:** Yes.

10 **JA:** So other people....

11 **SB:** Who took, who took the picture of you if you don't mind me asking who?

12 **JW:** I have no idea.

13 **SB:** How'd you get it?

14 **JW:** They mailed it to me.

15 **JA:** Who mailed it to you?

16 **JW:** Just somebody. It had a no, no address.

17 **JA:** I see.

18 **JW:** I've been getting hate mail on my computer too; e-mail.

19 **JA:** You've been getting, you've been getting hate mail?

20 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

21 **JA:** Uh, but somebody took a picture of you and then mailed it to you?

22 **JW:** Yes sir.

23 **JA:** Okay. Uhm, and you've been getting hate mail? Alright. Uhm, what prompted

24 you to go out there and hold the "Caylee's alive" sign?

25 **JW:** Because I believed she was still alive.

1 **JA:** Okay. And, and everybody's entitled...

2 **JW:** Uh...

3 **JA:** ...to have their, their opinion about whether she's alive or not. Uhm, you said,

4 did, do you still have the packaging this came in?

5 **JW:** No.

6 **JA:** You don't have the envelope this was mailed...

7 **JW:** No sir.

8 **JA:** ...to you in? Was there a note or anything with it, or was it just the photograph in

9 there?

10 **JW:** Uhm, I don't remember to be honest with you.

11 **JA:** You don't remember? Okay, so there could have been a, a hate mail letter?

12 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative).

13 **JA:** You just don't remember whether you got it or not?

14 **JW:** Exactly.

15 **JA:** Okay.

16 **SB:** If you had received a letter with it would you have remembered it?

17 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative), I think I would.

18 **JA:** But you don't know, okay?

19 **JW:** Uhm, I don't want to say yes or no.

20 **JA:** Okay.

21 **JW:** I don't remember.

22 **JA:** Okay. And that, and that's fine. Okay.

23 **JW:** I can't remember everything.

24 **JA:** No, no, I understand that. But we're, you know, obviously if you're getting....

25 **JW:** Yeah (affirmative).

1 **JA:** ...if you're getting hate mail and stuff...

2 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

3 **JA:** You know that's uh...

4 **JW:** We had our windows bashed out too.

5 **JA:** Who had your, you and your husband?

6 **JW:** To my car, yeah (affirmative).

7 **JA:** Okay.

8 **JW:** Because we were followed from a search one time.

9 **JA:** I see.

10 **JW:** And 911 they were trying to run us off the road.

11 **JA:** Uh, when you were searching with Equisearch?

12 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

13 **JA:** I see. Okay, did you report that?

14 **JW:** Oh, yeah (affirmative).

15 **JA:** Okay.

16 **JW:** I had the tag number and they never found them. They never did anything.

17 **JA:** Did you report that to the Sheriff's Office, the police, Orlando Police, or do you

18 remember if you....

19 **JW:** Orange County, Casselberry, uh, they followed me all the way from TPC to all

20 the way to Altamonte Springs.

21 **JA:** Okay.

22 **JW:** They got to my hometown Altamonte Mall.

23 **JA:** Okay.

24 **JW:** And my friend, who is a cop, he met me there, and he made sure I got home

25 safely.

1 **JA:** Okay, alrighty.

2 **JW:** And they, they never found them.

3 **JA:** (Coughs.) Alright, and this uh, uh, is a photograph or postcard. This is uh....

4 **JW:** From George.

5 **JA:** From George? Okay. And this is to your daughter? Okay.

6 **JW:** Abigail.

7 **JA:** It says, "To Abigail."

8 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

9 **JA:** "Thank you so much for the beautiful photo of you. I uh, and you and I."

10 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

11 **JA:** "Happy Thanksgiving also. George." And It's mailed, it looks like this is your  
12 address that they....

13 **JW:** Yes sir.

14 **JA:** It looks like he mailed it to your daughter uhm, Abigail Wray, at 951 Blackwood  
15 Street. Is that right?

16 **JW:** Yes sir.

17 **JA:** Okay, and let's see, it looks like you got it uh, you actually got this, it's  
18 postmarked November the 28<sup>th</sup>. So, you received it pretty recently?

19 **JW:** Yes.

20 **JA:** Okay. Uhm, after November 28<sup>th</sup>, the end of November you got, is when it got to  
21 you in the mail? Okay. And it's a postcard. On the other side it says, "Help find  
22 Caylee."

23 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

24 **JA:** Some photographs of Caylee?

25 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

1 **JA:** Alrighty. Okay. Alrighty. And then uh, you also have a, it looks like a series of  
2 three photographs that were taken of, of the ground....

3 **JW:** That was a....

4 **JA:** ...with some....

5 **JW:** ....pillowcase.

6 **JA:** A pillowcase?

7 **JW:** It was (unintelligible).

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** Uhm, it smelled really bad. I'm going to be honest with you, I didn't like the smell  
10 of it.

11 **JA:** Okay.

12 **JW:** So I ripped it apart.

13 **JA:** (Inaudible.)

14 **JW:** And I didn't find anything in there.

15 **JA:** Alright so and these take, these, these photographs were taken uhm, obviously  
16 after you ripped it apart, right?

17 **JW:** Yes.

18 **JA:** Okay. So you found a pillow, uh, uh, that looks like a pillow, a pillowcase. Is it a  
19 pillow or pillowcase?

20 **JW:** It was a pillow.

21 **JA:** A pillow. Okay, so you found a pillow. It was, it was sewn together. It was, it  
22 wasn't damaged when you found it?

23 **JW:** It was sewed together, but there was a little rip in it.

24 **JA:** Okay. When you say a little rip how, how, what's a little rip?

25 **JW:** About like that. Like somebody cut it with a knife.

1 **JA:** I see. Okay. And then you ripped the pillow apart like (unintelligible)...

2 **JW:** Because it smelled like....

3 **JA:** Like what?

4 **JW:** Like something died.

5 **JA:** Okay.

6 **JW:** I smelled something bad. I smelled something bad in that area.

7 **JA:** Okay, when you ripped the pillow apart did you, was there anything inside of it?

8 **JW:** Huh-huh (negative).

9 **JA:** Okay. And then there looks like a picture of somebody's foot?

10 **JW:** That's mine.

11 **JA:** Your foot? Okay.

12 **JW:** And that's....

13 **JA:** And....

14 **JW:** ...a log where it looked like somebody tried to start a fire.

15 **JA:** A log? Okay, and it, what's this other stuff?

16 **JW:** That is the pillowcase there.

17 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

18 **JW:** And I found a cigarette out there. I have it at the house.

19 **JA:** Okay.

20 **JW:** Hmm.

21 **JA:** So you took the cigarette home? And, and were these, these photographs were

22 taken when?

23 **JW:** Two months ago.

24 **JA:** Two months ago? Okay, you were searching with who at that time?

25 **JW:** When I, well at that time I was by myself.

1 **JA:** Okay, so you were, you were by yourself. Okay. And you took these pictures.  
2 And what did you do after you took these pictures? What....  
3 **JW:** I went home.  
4 **JA:** Okay. Uh, what, what did you take the pictures for? What was the, what was the  
5 purpose of taking the photographs?  
6 **JW:** Because I want to find the truth of what happened to this little girl.  
7 **JA:** Right, right. And I think uh, I think all, we all, we all want to find. But if you, if you  
8 took the pictures, you did what with them after you got them home?  
9 **JW:** Nothing. Just kept them on my computer and I just printed these out uh, about a  
10 week ago.  
11 **JA:** Okay. Alright. And you say that uh, and when you took them, the pictures of  
12 these pillows, uh, this was about thirty feet....  
13 **JW:** Thirty or forty feet from the fence.  
14 **JA:** Thirty to forty feet? Okay. Alright. Uhm, alright.

2 Eq...any, any search with Equisearch?  
3 **JW:** Yup (affirmative).  
4 **JA:** Yes? Okay. And uh, who was with you then?  
5 **JW:** Myself.  
6 **JA:** Okay, all by yourself? Okay.  
7 **JW:** My husband was at work.  
8 **JA:** I see. Okay.  
9 **JW:** And the kids were at school.  
10 **JA:** Okay. And what prompted you to come here to search? Uh, I'm, I'm, I'm just  
11 curious as opposed to any other uh, area around here.  
12 **JW:** My gut feeling.  
13 **JA:** Your gut feeling? Okay. Alrighty. Did you uh, search any other places or just  
14 here?  
15 **JW:** Just there.

1 **JW:** Never found a body.

2 **JA:** Uhm, you never found a body? Well let me, let me ask you this. Uh, when you  
3 got back in there uh, obviously there's uh, to try to kind of get some reference to  
4 where you were, uhm, I'm looking at some of the vegetation there. What kind of  
5 trees were around? Do, do you remember?

6 **JW:** Just those. Uhm...

7 **JA:** Those, okay.

8 **JW:** I think there's like a little....

9 **JA:** Uh-hum (affirmative).

10 **JW:** ....uh, what are these called, ferns?

11 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative).

12 **JW:** There was a fern.

13 **JA:** At the, at the bottom, uh, at the bottom of the trees do you remember what the  
14 trees looked like at the bottom?

15 **JW:** I don't remember.

16 **JA:** You don't remember? Okay.

17 **JW:** I'm sorry.

18 **JA:** Uh, n, no problem. I'm just trying to, I'm trying to figure out, because there's  
19 different types of trees in there and....

20 **JW:** There's a lot of different trees.

21 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative). Yeah (affirmative). Okay.

22 **SB:** When was the, when was the second time you came out there Joy?

23 **JA:** The second time? Probably (sighs) three weeks later.

24 **SB:** So that'd put us into August?

25 **JW:** Yes.

1 **JA:** Okay.

2 **SB:** Okay.

3 **JW:** I've been out there a lot.

4 **JA:** Alright. When you were in there, and this is, this is uh, this is something that'd be  
5 very helpful to us, do you remember any of the time, the ten times, or so times  
6 that you're in there, well did you ever see any standing water?

7 **JW:** Yes....

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** ...there was water.

10 **JA:** There was water? Okay. Did you ever get any sense of how deep it might be?

6 **JA:** Okay.  
7 **SB:** When, when was that?  
8 **JW:** When did I....  
9 **SB:** When was the first, when was the first time you were in there with water?  
10 **JW:** When uh, Equisearch was doing their searches.  
11 **JA:** Okay. So when Equisearch was in there doing their searches, that was wet?  
12 There was water in there?  
13 **JW:** I think so.  
14 **JA:** Okay. And how many, how many of the Equisearches, how many, how many  
15 times....  
16 **JW:** How many searches?  
17 **JA:** Yeah (affirmative), how many times did you search it?

5 deeper or less, or do you recall when that was?

6 **JW:** Uhm, I think it was getting, it was getting deeper. Because the most rain we had  
7 was in October.

8 **JA:** Okay.

9 **JW:** And I, and I came back in October too.

10 **JA:** I see. Alright, uhm, (sighs), when you first went out there with Equisearch, when  
11 you first, went, went with Equisearch, uhm, obviously you took some pictures at  
12 Blanchard Park with Equisearch, did you fill out any kind of paperwork....

13 **JW:** Yes, I did.

14 **JA:** ...for them? Okay. Did you sign it?

15 **JW:** Yes, I did.

23 **JW:** Uh-hum (affirmative).


