5 CE – CORPORAL ERIC EDWARDS  
6 SA – SERGEANT JOHN ALLEN  
7 LT – LINDA TINELLI

8  
9 It's ah, December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2009, it's approximately 1:03 p.m. Corporal Eric Edwards  
10 Orange County Sheriff's Office, in the conference room at John Young and 50  
11 with..

12 SA Sergeant John Allen.

13 CE And...

14 LT Linda Tinelli.

15 CE Linda, can you raise your right hand for me? You swear all the information  
16 You give today will be true?

17 LT Yes.

18 CE Okay. Um, Linda I had contacted you through my investigation. Your  
19 information came to my ah, attention and that you worked at the Kid  
20 Finders tent or one of the tents that was established by the Anthony's.  
21 When Caylee first went missing is that correct.

22 LT Yes.

23 CE Okay. Um, and I know it redundant, but we spent a little bit of time here  
24 Speaking before we went on tape to collect a sworn statement from you. Can  
25 You tell me again your recollection of how it came to be that you got involved?

1 LT Right after I heard the story on television I went down there was a tent in the  
2 middle of a parking lot. Down at Publix on Chickasaw and Lake Underhill. And I  
3 met Cindy and there was a couple other people there I met them. And I asked if I  
4 could help and I left my name and my phone number and they said they would  
5 contact me to work at the tent or the table as we called it.

6 CE And that was like in the first few days of...

7 LT I'd say towards the end of July.

8 CE End of July?

9 LT Two thousand and eight.

10 CE Who, who were the primary people responsible for that, that tent at that  
11 time? I think you had said a girl by the name of Holly seemed to play  
12 that role?  
13

14 LT Yes um, Cindy was at the, the tent that day. Um, I don't know if Holly was  
15 there that day. But the next... (phone)..

16 CE I apologize. I'll have to call you back. Okay. Sorry about that.

17 LT That's okay. But, but Holly had basically taken it over for George and Cindy.  
18 Um, and I left my name and number like I said. Holly was there I think and  
19 Cindy, I know Cindy was. And Lee's girlfriend, Mallory and I think George's  
20 Sister. And while I was there talking with Cindy George had pulled in and  
21 The only thing I heard him say to Cindy was, "We have to go." And I  
22 left and they left.  
23

24 CE Okay. Now who reached out to you to see if you would come back and  
25 Assist with organizing different ah, locations?

1 LT Holly called me.  
2 CE Holly did?  
3 LT Yes.  
4 CE Okay. How man locations are you aware of that, that tent moved to or that  
5 Operation moved to?  
6 LT Six.  
7 CE Six. Can you tell me the locations?  
8 LT It started out on Chickasaw and Lake Underhill. We moved to Publix on  
9 Chickasaw and Curryford. Then we moved to the fruit stand on Curryford and  
10 Goldenrod. Then we moved to Wal-Mart out there on Hoffner.  
11  
12 CE Okay.  
13 LT And then we moved to in front.. beside the Roller Rink on Goldenrod.  
14 CE Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
15 LT And then we moved to in front of the FEMA buildings on Goldenrod.  
16 That was the last.  
17 CE Now you had said that George asked you to organize um, people that were  
18 volunteering to come for ah, spread their time out.  
19 Lt Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
20 CE And you said you were keeping track of those names?  
21 LT Yes. After Holly had left ah, she had to take kids to school and she had a  
22 Little girl. George had called me and asked me if I would kind of like  
23 coordinate it, you know with names and stuff, he would appreciate it. And I  
24 I volunteered to do that. And that's what I did with the names and people  
25

1           Would stop and leave their names if they could help. They would ask  
2           George or me what they could do and I would say, volunteer or George would  
3           say could volunteer give me a couple hours of your time to work the table.  
4 CE       Were you at the tables most days or...  
5 LT       I wouldn't say everyday, but I was there a lot.  
6 CE       A lot.  
7 LT       Yeah.  
8 CE       And what days of the week usually were the tents open?  
9 LT       Well usually seven days a week in the beginning.  
10 CE      Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
11 LT      And then I don't know exactly when. Um, I don't know maybe August  
12           2009, September something.. No, I'm sorry I believe it was November um, we  
13           went down to Thursday through Monday. It was closed Tuesdays and  
14           Wednesdays.  
15 CE      Um, with your experience with being there quite often how often was Cindy  
16           there?  
17 LT      Cindy would stop down, but she wasn't at the table that much.  
18 CE      No.  
19 LT      No. Maybe in the beginning before I started, but after I started and I  
20           Started probably the end of July, 2008. She wasn't there much. She would  
21           Stop down to see George for something. But...  
22 CE      Was she keeping track of names or anything like that? Or was that just you..  
23           Primarily?

1 LT Basically that was just me. And then Gabby had done it for a little while.  
2 A lady by the name Gabby that was thee. But then it was basically me.  
3 CE Knowing what you know now and seeing the faces on TV and all the players.  
4 That... Well do you recall Roy Kronk ever visiting any of those tents or  
5 locations?  
6 LT Not that I know of I never seen him there. Anytime I ever seen him that I  
7 recollect is on TV.  
8 CE Is there any conversation now about from any of those people that were at any of  
9 those tents, is anybody articulated to you or discussed with you that looking  
10 back at it now that they know that Roy Kronk was visiting those tents or  
11 meandering around the area at all?  
12  
13 LT No.  
14 CE Okay. Not to your knowledge?  
15 LT Not to my knowledge.  
16 CE And Cindy Anthony hasn't mentioned that or Holly or anyone?  
17 LT No.  
18 CE Okay.  
19 SA How about has anybody ever said that they, that they recall him hanging around  
20 the Anthony house or showing any interest in, ah, Caylee?  
21  
22 LT No.  
23 CE In this even the most recent visits where you been to the churches and the  
24 visual.. vigils and the greetings. Ah, and Cindy or George has never said, hey  
25 we know that guy or that guy's been around us before?

1 LT No.

2 CE Okay. So, this is new stuff to you?

3 LT Yes.

4 CE Alright. Um, I can cross it off farther down on the sheets here. But that

5 George had requested from you after we recovered the bod.. the remains or a

6 set of remains. Let's leave it at that. Ah, he had contacted you asking for that

7 list of volunteers you stated?

8

9 LT Yes.

10 CE Tell me about that.

11 LT Um, he'd just called and said he wan... we had a book. I had typed all

12 The names up and phone numbers of people that had left their phones to

13 Volunteer, not everybody did. But there was some people on there that did

14 Of course when I called 'em. And he just wanted the book to I guess call

15 'em and thank 'em for their help at the table before Cay.. Caylee was

16 found.

17 SA Did he say to you that's why he wanted the book?

18 LT Yes.

19 SA Okay.

20 CE Okay, but now you know that he had never made those appreciation calls?

21

22 LT Not that I know of, I never talked to the people I don't know if he called or not.

23 CE Okay, but you printed that.. you say you.. you took that home and you typed that.

24 So, you provided George a copy of what you have?

25 LT Yes.

1 CE Okay, so you currently have what you had given him?  
2 LT Yes.  
3 CE A copy of? So, we could get that from you so we can look at it?  
4 LT Yeah.  
5 CE Okay. Um, real quick money. There was ah, donations that were made via the  
6 mail? Ah...  
7 LT I guess I never seen it.  
8 CE Okay.  
9 LT I don't know.  
10 CE That was the email stuff where people requesting certain things?  
11 LT Yeah they would, they would I guess email George or Cindy and they would want  
12 I guess they sent donations I don't know I never seen money. But they would  
13 want a T-shirt or they would want a bracelet or a pin or whatever. And I know  
14 one day I sat down there it was on the um, I think it was down at Hoffner I sat  
15 there and I, I wrote out a bunch of envelopes that George had given me and he  
16 mails what the people wanted. Like two T-shirts we would put ;em in a bag and  
17 I'd write the name and address and George picked 'em up and said he was  
18 taking 'em to the post office and mail 'em out to 'em.  
19 CE No idea what happened to 'em?  
20 LT No he picked 'em up said he was taking 'em to the post office and mail 'em.  
21 CE Okay. Ah, there was a jar there that.. cash donations were left in from time to  
22 time?  
23 LT Correct.

1 CE Who would empty that jar?

2 LT Um, they would come and, and I would leave it in the, in the trailer Kid Finder's  
3 trailer.

4 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

5 LT And George would come and get it or he would, he would take it right there um,  
6 and said I guess he was gonna take it to the Caylee Anthony fund.

7 CE Okay.

8 LT I don't know if that's how they bought the T-shirts that they provided for Caylee  
9 for what.

10 CE Um, I think you said the third location there was a time where you guys were  
11 trying to set up camp there and table clothes were blowing off tables?

12 LT Yes.

13 CE Can you tell me about that?

14 LT Um, the table cloth was blowing off and we, at first we had Scotch tape and that  
15 wouldn't hold it and George said, I have something that'll hold it. And he brought  
16 some tape back.

17 CE And you don't recall exactly what the tape looked like?

18 LT No.

19 CE But it wasn't like a small Scotch tape it was a larger tape?

20 LT Right it wasn't Scotch tape it was like a roll of tape.

21 CE Okay.

22 LT Like electrical tape.

23 CE How, about how wide?

24

25

1 LT (No verbal response.)  
2 SA Um, you're.. you're holding your hands...  
3 LT Yeah.  
4 SA ....about a couple inches.  
5 LT How wide is... how wide is that, couple inches?  
6 SA Couple of inches.  
7 LT Yeah.  
8 CE Couple of inches wide?  
9 LT Yeah.  
10 CE Okay. I just in my mind's eye electrical tape...  
11 LT I don't...  
12 CE ... is slender  
13 LT No, no.  
14 CE And, and ah...  
15 LT It was I don't know it was rougher then electrical, electrical tape's smooth.  
16 SA Right.  
17 LT It was like rough, rougher.  
18 CE And once it was on the table once you taped this stuff to the table and the table  
19 clothes down did it remain there? Did, was...  
20 LT Yes.  
21 CE Okay so for a period of time were you able to keep moving that table with that  
22 sane cloth on it from location to location due to that tape or..  
23 LT No 'cause they would rip, they were like, like..

1 SA The tablecloths would rip or the tape would rip?  
2 LT Tablecloths 'cause they were like you know when you put stuff on the table they  
3 would rip. They were just like the plastic, like they only cost a dollar. They were  
4 the plastic..  
5 CE Who took the tape from George and taped it? Or did George tape it himself? Is  
6 there someone that we could talk to that may say, that I can recall more about  
7 that tape?  
8  
9 LT I put, I out some tape on.  
10 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
11 LT At the other tables 'cause when the table clothes would get ripped we'd take 'em  
12 off and tape 'em down. But I.. I can't tell you what it looked like.  
13 CE Was it easy to rip or did you have to cut it with something or you recall?  
14 LT I think we cut it.  
15 CE Cut it.  
16 LT Yeah.  
17 CE Okay. And who else would've witnessed that or been a part of that you think?  
18 LT Um, whoever was there maybe Karen helped him. Karen Grover G-R-O-V... G-  
19 R-O-O-V-E-R. She might've of I don't know.  
20 CE Well you have her phone number?  
21 LT Not with me. I don't, I don't know it.  
22 CE Have it at the house?  
23 LT (No verbal response.)  
24  
25

1 CE Okay. Alright. Um, while we're talking about that you had stated that there was  
2 a point in time where George said that he had information that Ca.. ah, Caylee  
3 maybe in Puerto Rico. And that he would cry from time to time. Can you tell me  
4 about that again?

5 LT Like we always be upset at the table and you know people would always stop  
6 and they would hug him and they would tell him how sorry they were about the  
7 situation. And he would, he would get upset and you know he would always tell  
8 me that she was alive and he believed she was in Puerto Rico or he believed she  
9 was here or there. And there was spottings I think where ever it was that was on  
10 TV, there was spottings. And he was hoping you know that this was it and he..  
11 he thought it was that time that they found her.. not found her I'm sorry. The time  
12 that they spotted her at the mall.

14 SA Okay.

15 LT Walking down there he, I think he really thought that was her.

16 CE Who took that picture did he say?

17 LT What picture?

18 CE The one at the mall.

19 LT Oh I had no idea. He never said who took it.

20 SA You said something about Puerto Rico. Ah, um, did ah, George said he thought  
21 she was in Puerto Rico.

22 LT Yep he thought...

23 SA You remember when that was?

24 LT No.

1 SA Did he ah, did he tell you how he came about the information in Puerto Rico?  
2 Did he mention anybody's name the information came from that (Inaudible)...

3 LT I think him and Dominic were talk.. Dominic Casey.

4 SA Yeah.

5 LT I think him and Dominic were talking.

6 SA Why do you think that?

7 LT Um, he had mentioned Dominic that Dominic was on the trail and they were  
8 close to find her. They were, they were always like two or three days behind.  
9 Two days behind where Caylee was. Like I, I guess he meant if they heard  
10 today.. they heard today she was in Puerto Rico. That was like three days ago  
11 you know?

12

13 SA Right. Did ah, you have conversations with Dominic about Puerto Rico? Or  
14 anything about where Caylee perhaps was?

15 LT Yes I had ah, I talked to Dominic maybe two or three times. I talked to him, last  
16 time I talked to Dominic was at the church at the vigil.

17 SA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

18 LT On December 7<sup>th</sup>, the last vigil that they had, Sunday.

19 CE You'd said that he asked you to call him.

20

21 LT On Monday next day 'cause I had given him a letter from a lady and he said it  
22 was very credible. I'd given him that about two weeks prior to December 7<sup>th</sup> and  
23 he said that letter was very credible and he would like to meet with her and  
24 myself. And that I could call him on Monday the next day and he would set up a  
25

1 meeting sometime that week for us to meet. And we were gonna meet at my  
2 house at the time.

3 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

4 LT And ah, I called him that Monday, the next day and he was busy at the time. I  
5 don't know what he was doing, but he was busy. And he said he would call me  
6 back.

7 CE And he never has?

8 LT No.

9 CE So, we find the body a short time after you were suppose to meet Dominic with a  
10 credible lead.

11 CE Correct.

12 CE And now that we've found a body, not knowing whose yet, but a body. That the  
13 lead investigator for the Anthony family doesn't call you back with the credible tip.  
14 When they're two days behind the body everywhere they go. Two days behind  
15 the girl.

16 LT (No verbal response)

17 CE So...

18 LT Correct.

19 CE ...my point being here's a detective working for the family two days behind where  
20 ever this child is traveling. And they never call you to sit down with someone  
21 who has a credible lead?

22 LT No.

23

24

25

1 CE So, the body's found or a body's found. That would, that would potentially lead  
2 us to a suspect if she was traveling around every two days. And they still haven't  
3 called up back?  
4 LT No.  
5 CE Just for clarification. Okay.  
6 SA Um, how many times you say you talked to Dominic Casey?  
7 LT Three or four.  
8 SA Three or four. During those three or four times ah, I mean we are certainly  
9 interested and you know that we've talked to Dominic Casey. Ah, he's come and  
10 giving us a statement.  
11  
12 LT Okay,  
13 SA Um, did he ever talk to you about um, his interactions with psychics on the case?  
14 LT No.  
15 SA Did he ever and I'm looking through some emails that ah, email exchanges  
16 between Dominic and other people, who are helping him in regards to this  
17 investigation. Did he ever talk to you about hitting the big.. let me read from  
18 here. "The big boys and girls at the top of the trafficking escort Medicaid fraud  
19 scheme.. scheme and ah, these people be, these people singing."  
20  
21 LT No.  
22 SA Huh? He never talked to you about that?  
23 LT No.  
24  
25

1 SA Did he ever talk to you about Casey enjoying a lifetime club and getting in too  
2 deep and having to um, to get out of this lifetime club. Ah, and get herself into  
3 protective custody or..

4 LT No.

5 SA ... never mentioned that to you?

6 LT No.

7 SA Um, did he ever talk to you about George molesting Casey?

8 LT No.

9 SA Did he ever talk to you about ah, you said earlier you said something about  
10 Puerto Rico. Or George said something about Puerto Rico?  
11

12 LT Correct.

13 SA Did ah, Dominic ever mention to you that or say to you that ah, he had made this  
14 story up to trick Jose Baez because Baez was demanding information?

15 LT No.

16 SA He ever say to you that he made up a story about ah, let's see here... Caylee  
17 was flown on a private jet from Orlando Executive Airport to San Juan Puerto  
18 Rico. And held there until plans were made to take her out of the country to  
19 Columbia? She was then taken across the border into Venezuela to Porta San  
20 Rosa, near Porta Cumma (Inaudible)... Knowing there would be no extradition or  
21 investigation possible due to the prevailing diplomatic situation. No other details  
22 can be released until such time Caylee can be positively identification and an  
23 extraction is in play. He never tell you ..  
24

25 LT That Dominic ever tell me that?

1 SA Yeah.

2 LT No.

3 SA Ever came up with a....

4 CE Did anyone ever tell you that?

5 LT Just about Puerto Rico.

6 SA Right. But none of this about...

7 CE Who.. who..

8 SA ...(Inaudible)...

9 CE ...told you that, George?

10 LT George, yeah.

11 CE Okay.

12 LT But Dominic never did.

13 SA Oh they never.. neither.. none of them ever says that they knew that she had

14 been flown by private jet to Puerto Rico and then to Venezuela?

15

16 LT No.

17 SA Or ah, or having an extraction in play?

18 LT No.

19 SA None of that sounds familiar to you?

20

21 LT No.

22 SA Um, how about ah, anything about major drug transaction with a Puerto Rican

23 mob with ties to Fusion?

24 LT No.

25 SA None of that sounds familiar to you?

1 LT No.

2 SA Um, and you never heard either one of them say anything about.. let me find it  
3 here. About coming up with something to trick, to play a trick ah, no one ever  
4 said something about playing a trick on, on Mr. Baez?

5 LT No.

6 SA Making this up 'cause he'd gotten money?

7 LT No.

8 SA He never talked to you about Geraldo going to Puerto Rico and, and providing  
9 money anybody?

10

11 LT Who?

12 SA Geraldo Rivera.

13 LT Oh, no.

14 SA Okay. So, this would all be news to you? You're unaware that....

15 LT Yes.

16 SA ...you're unaware of any of this?

17 LT Right.

18 SA Okay.

19 CE So, now in conversation with George and Dominic Casey and being present for  
20 some of those things we obviously weren't invited to. There was never any  
21 discussion about the ongoing efforts to find Caylee in Puerto Rico? Just that she  
22 may be there? And they were always two days behind where she was?

23

24 LT No, I believe George had said to me that Dominic was going down to Puerto  
25 Rico.

1 CE Okay.

2 LT 'Cause I don't know how they knew or who told them that they believed that  
3 Caylee was in Puerto Rico.

4 CE Do you know if he ever made it there?

5 LT I do not know.

6 CE Okay.

7 LT You mean Dominic?

8 CE (No verbal response.)

9 LT Yeah I don't know.

10 CE Any of 'em?

11 LT No I don't know.

12 CE I know that they went on a cruise, but I don't know if it swung by Puerto Rico.

13 LT (No verbal response.)

14 CE I don't know if anybody put forth any effort to actually visit Puerto Rico.

15 LT Oh you mean lately?

16 CE Anytime.

17 LT Oh I don't know.

18 CE Searching for a killer or the child prior to discovery.

19 LT That I don't know.

20 CE Okay. Um, are you done with that email...

21 SA I just want to.. ah, you're sure they never said anything about Casey joining a  
22 lifetime club or being involved ah, or Dominic hitting the big boys and girls at the  
23 top of the trafficking escort service Medicaid fraud?  
24  
25

1 LT No.

2 SA And you're sure you never heard 'em say anything about ah, making this stuff up  
3 about Puerto Rico to play a trick on Jose Baez?

4 LT No.

5 SA Ah, coming up with the red haring many hundreds of miles away? None of that  
6 ever...

7 LT No.

8 SA Okay.

9 CE Did they ever discuss with you or George or any of the inner circle there at the  
10 tent. Um, what they think may have happened? And why Casey didn't come  
11 forward with this quicker or ever for that matter? The, that, that the baby was  
12 missing?

13

14 LT George had made a statement one time that she's got mixed up with the wrong  
15 people. And he thought that I guess the people that she was gone on vacation  
16 with. They were all involved some how.

17 CE He said that they were?

18 LT Yes whoever she was gone on vacation with. Was gonna go on vacation with,  
19 didn't go.

20 CE Okay. So, he feels or they felt that Ricardo and Amy Huizenga and Troy and the,  
21 the little social group that she had made herself a part of. Prior to dating Tony  
22 Lazzaro, was responsible? For...

23

24 LT I don't know about responsible, but I guess they knew what had happened.

25 CE Do he ever theorize what that was?

1 LT No.

2 CE No, he just said they would know? Or should know?

3 LT That he thought they were, they were involved. That they knew.

4 CE Um, let's go to the day that, that we make or Roy Kronk makes the discovery and  
5 law enforcement becomes involved down there off Suburban. You had said that  
6 that Friday morning on the 12<sup>th</sup>, Dennis and Sherry from Kids Finder, called you.

7 LT Uh-huh. (Affirmative) Yes.

8 CE Can you, can you give me that account again?

9 LT Um, they called me around ten o'clock and asked if my daughter and I could  
10 come down and help remove the tent. And they get it down and out of there I  
11 guess they were afraid since you found a body. That they were afraid they would  
12 destroy um, I guess the tables and rip up the tent and whatever the bill... bill  
13 board. And so my daughter and I met Sherry and Dennis down there.

14 CE Down where?

15 LT Um, at the table, the tent.

16 CE What, ah, what location? Now we're at the...

17 LT Goldenrod in front of the FEMA.

18 CE The FEMA building?

19 LT Yes.

20 CE Okay.

21 LT And um, we went down and there was Sherry and Dennis, my daughter and me  
22 and Gabby and her husband. And we were, we took the tent down 'cause it was  
23 hard to get down. And we took the tent down and Dennis had taking the picture  
24  
25

1 of Caylee out of the billboard. It was canvas he had ripped it out up top around  
2 and rolled it up and put it like in the billboard area. And they had a storage up on  
3 Dean and Alafaya. I'm sorry, I'm sorry Dean and ...

4 SA Earlier you said Lake Underhill.

5 LT Lake Underhill. Yeah, Dean and Lake Underhill and they took the, they took the,  
6 the billboard and then we loaded it was either Sherry or Dennis' truck I forget  
7 which one it was. I think it was Sherry's a burgundy one. We took up to um, we  
8 took everything out of the trailer. Everything out of the trailer and put in the truck.  
9 I put some in my, my car. And, and somebody drove the billboard and then the  
10 truck and we took it up to the storage and out like the fliers and boxes they were  
11 in boxes and T-shirts. We put them in the storage and Sherry and Dennis  
12 unloaded the billboard trailer whatever it is. They unloaded that and they left it  
13 there 'cause there's places where you park them and parked boats and that stuff.  
14 And we put everything there was, there was pens and pins and T-shirts and fliers  
15 everything we put in the storage bin.

16  
17 CE I think that's when I shown... I showed you this colored photo. Let me go back  
18 this if you don't mind.

19 LT Hm.

20 CE Can you give me a signature right there by the X please. This is where I kind of  
21 asked you and I apologize for the quality of the image. But you had seemed to  
22 think that that photograph would've been what parking lot again?

23  
24 LT I think this was the one on Chickasaw and Curry Ford.

25 CE Okay.

1 LT I'm pretty sure.

2 CE Now the reason I shown you this is because the media has since come forward  
3 with these images due to the fact that the missing poster is stuck to the tent with  
4 a piece of tape. Um, and I had shown you this and this of course it can't be to  
5 scale due to it being photograph. Um, but this tape doesn't jump out? You don't  
6 know one way or another whether or not this was the tape that George brought to  
7 the ...

8 LT I do not know.

9 CE No?

10 CE No?

11 CE No.

12 CE So, you aren't able to say one way or the other?

13 LT Correct.

14 CE Okay. My question was though with that storage unit with the items that were  
15 taken down, posters and tent and garbage cans. Those were all delivered to that  
16 storage unit?

17 LT As far as I know.

18 CE Okay and whose name is that storage unit in?

19 LT And that again I don't know. I.. I think Sherry and Dennis 'cause they wouldn't be  
20 able to park their trailers there if it...

21 CE Right.

22 LT ...if it wasn't.

23 CE But they don't live here locally?

24 LT No.

25

1 CE Do you have phone numbers for them?

2 LT Yes.

3 CE Okay.

4 SA When, when ah, when.. how long ago was that stuff taken to the storage shed?

5 LT December 12<sup>th</sup>.

6 SA So, this is what you're discussing earlier that as soon as the body was found or a  
7 body was found near the house. Um, this .

8 LT The next day.

9 SA ....they decided to the search was over. You guys took the stuff down and you  
10 took it to that storage shed?

11

12 LT Correct.

13 SA Okay.

14 LT They were afraid that some of the protesters would come down and try to ruin the  
15 billboard and you know the poster and the billboard the canvas and the billboard.  
16 Or ruin the tables and they, they wanted to take it.. 'cause they I guess they  
17 rented the trailer.

18 SA Okay.

19 LT That they kept the stuff in I don't know where they rented it from, but they rented  
20 it. They didn't take the trailer.

21

22 SA To the storage unit?

23 LT No the company come and picked up the trailer.

24 SA They...

25 LT But the trailer was empty.

1 SA They took the, the posters and what have you and they stored that stuff in this  
2 storage unit and they...  
3 LT Correct.  
4 SA ...returned the trailer.  
5 LT Correct.  
6 SA Okay.  
7 CE You had said that when George had contacted you that you had returned back to  
8 that same storage unit area on the 16<sup>th</sup> of December to provide him that copy of  
9 the ..  
10  
11 LT Provide him the book and everything that was in it. Which was just a copy of that  
12 with all the phone numbers and names of people that had left a number ...  
13 SA Yeah.  
14 LT ...to volunteer.  
15 CE Okay and there was, it was a sign in book or ... ah...  
16 LT No what people would do..  
17 CE (Inaudible)...  
18 LT .... they would like on your tablet they would tear off a piece of paper write their  
19 name, write their phone number they could volunteer.  
20  
21 CE So, you kept those in that book? So...  
22 LT No, I threw them out.  
23 CE Okay.  
24  
25

1 LT I would type their name and phone number 'cause we didn't need twenty little  
2 pieces of paper. So, I would take it home and I would organized it I typed their  
3 name and their phone number or cell number, email whatever.  
4 SA But the actually pieces of paper that these people filled out...  
5 LT It's just..  
6 SA ...to volunteer.  
7 LT Right.  
8 SA You're saying they were destroyed?  
9 LT Correct.  
10 SA Okay. Alright. Who, who destroyed them?  
11 LT I did.  
12 SA You did. Yeah..  
13 LT Yeah.  
14 SA Nobody had an issue with you destroying them? Nobody said, hey don't destroy  
15 that we night need 'em later?  
16 LT No.  
17 SA No one said anything at all?  
18 LT No 'cause they were like, like I said you tear a piece of paper off they wrote their  
19 name and then I would transfer their name from that little scratch of paper onto a  
20 list.  
21  
22 SA Okay.  
23 CE What kind of lock did they put back on that storage unit, you remember? Was it  
24 a key lock or combination?  
25

1 LT Yes.

2 CE It was key lock?

3 LT Key lock.

4 CE Who had the key?

5 LT They would leave it at... well there for a while I had the key at the end, I had the

6 key. Um, sometimes they, and I think George had a key. I don't even know if

7 Sherry and Dennis had one, but I think George had one, I had one. At the end I

8 had one. Um, or sometimes they would just hide it like, like the trailer had a little

9 window in it.

10

11 CE Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

12 LT Like that and they, they had a poster up of Caylee over the window. And they

13 would hide the key behind the window.

14 CE So, you, you had access to that storage unit to travel back and forth and get T-

15 shirts and fliers and things..

16 LT Not the storage unit the trailer.

17 CE Okay that's what I meant I apologize. The storage unit.

18 LT Oh that I didn't have that.

19 CE Did it have a combination lock or a turn lock or...

20 LT I don't know.

21 CE Don't know.

22 LT No.

23 CE So, when you guys went there and unloaded it who opened it?

24 LT Sherry or Dennis.

25

1 CE Okay.

2 LT 'Cause George was not with us. In fact...

3 CE Ah...

4 LT ....I can tell you 'cause we got half.. we got half way up the road and Sherry  
5 called me on my cell. And she said, go up there and wait.. we went back there  
6 and we turned around we went back down Dennis had the key. And 'cause  
7 Sherry forgot the key. And we got the key from Dennis and took it back to  
8 Sherry.

9

10 CE Okay. Down where..

11 LT So, Sherry must've opened it.

12 CE I apologize when we were on the Dominic Casey issues you had stated that he  
13 didn't appear genuine. Um, in most of the things he was saying.

14 LT Well he wouldn't, he wouldn't tell me very much. He said he couldn't discuss it.  
15 He couldn't discuss the case. But I had given him a letter one time and he said  
16 that the letter was credible and he wanted to meet with that lady and myself.

17 SA You remember what the letter said?

18 LT Yeah it said that um, oh she had seen.. I have a copy of the letter at home if you  
19 need it.

20 SA Well, since it, what.. what did the letter say? Did it say that, was it like a  
21 sighting...

22

23 LT That she had seen... yeah that she had seen Casey out there on um, she had  
24 seen her on July 5<sup>th</sup>, she had seen her on Halloween night. Um, I don't.. it had I  
25 don't know had people's names in it, it had license plate numbers in it. And a

1 bunch of stuff in it and he wanted to sit down talk to her, I don't know exactly but  
2 he wanted to sit down talk to her. He told me it was credible.  
3 CE You've since learned that it's not a credible source of information?  
4 LT I guess I...  
5 SA Did he ever to your knowledge do you know this woman?  
6 LT Yes.  
7 SA Do you know if Dominic Casey ever contacted her?  
8 LT He has not.  
9 SA So, this is a woman who sited Caylee in July and in October and he never  
10 contacted..  
11 LT And seen Casey out there on June 20<sup>th</sup>.  
12 CE June 20<sup>th</sup>.  
13 LT Correct.  
14 CE This woman says she saw Casey on June 20<sup>th</sup>..  
15 LT Yes.  
16 CE ...but Dominic to your knowledge Dominic Casey has not contacted her to look  
17 into that?  
18 LT No I know he has not contacted her. Well I guess you never a hundred percent  
19 sure she would've told me.  
20 SA You spoken to her since?  
21 LT Yeah.  
22 SA You ever ask her whether she got.. whether Dominic called her?  
23  
24  
25

1 LT Yeah 'cause she is upset with any.. everybody nobody's contacted her. And she  
2 says, I know what I... I mean she is determined to this day, to this day she know  
3 what she saw. And she knows what she's heard.  
4 SA And you said earlier that she used a more then one name. What was.. do you  
5 know other names she used?  
6 LT What do you mean?  
7 SA You said that Roxy, but you said she went by another name as well.  
8 LT Well she at first say back in July of 2008.  
9 SA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)  
10 LT She didn't want people to know her name. So, she just called herself Sally.  
11 SA Okay.  
12 LT And since then she's ...  
13 CE What's her name?  
14 LT Roxy.  
15 CE What's her real, her full real name?  
16 LT Roxy Marshall.  
17 CE Marshall. Okay. Um, we were discussing...  
18 LT And George said that George had told me one time that, that everything she said  
19 wasn't true.  
20 SA How'd he know that?  
21 LT Don't know. She.. I, I know George had said he had spoken with you about it.  
22 SA Yes.  
23 CE Hm. And Dominic Casey called you to inquire maybe make his job little easier?

1 CE No but I did have a conversation with George and I know the woman who you're  
2 referring to 'cause I did have some conversations with her. We did take, get  
3 information in Seminole County. We did send the Seminole County Sheriff's  
4 Office out there to meet with her. At the time we were getting lots of tips so  
5 (Inaudible)... I don't know whether they did or didn't that's why I asking you.  
6 You're telling me you had conversations with her.

7  
8 LT Correct.

9 SA And she's telling you that Dominic Casey after you provided information to  
10 Dominic he never followed up with her.

11 LT I talked to her probably every day.

12 SA You still talk to her everyday?

13 LT Yes.

14 SA Okay. Did she ever, did she ever tell you that the Seminole, that she had, that  
15 she had contact with the Seminole County Sheriff's Office?

16 LT About this?

17 SA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

18 LT No.

19 SA Okay.

20  
21 LT Well, she had contact with I don't know what it was about, but it was around that  
22 time.

23 SA Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

24

25

1 LT With Seminole about a guy by the name of Jamie. The police went down there  
2 and asked him his name or something for some reason. And he gave a wrong  
3 name to the Seminole County Police. And when they come back to her door.  
4 SA Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
5 LT She said I head him tell you his name was... And I don't know what he told her.  
6 And she said that's not true his name's Jamie.  
7 SA But she, she told you that somebody from Seminole County did, she did talk with  
8 Seminole County?  
9 LT But I don't know if it was about this case. I don't, I don't know what it was about.  
10 But I know Jamie was suppose to be a friend of Ca... um, Casey's.  
11 SA Okay. Alright.  
12 LT And she had seen Caylee out there on June 20<sup>th</sup>, they were putting stuff in the  
13 car.  
14 Looked like they were going to the beach.  
15 SA Did she ever ah, how well do you know her?  
16 LT How well?  
17 SA Uh-huh. (affirmative). You say you talk to her everyday. Do you know her  
18 pretty well?  
19 LT I guess.  
20 SA You ever known her to have um, mental health issues?  
21 LT I know right after this case started and just by her telling me.  
22 Sa Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
23 LT Um, I don't know if it was like the beginning of August she went somewhere  
24  
25



1 and I don't where for five days. And all she told me she was in section C.  
2 Whatever that is.  
3 SA Okay.  
4 LT (Inaudible)...  
5 CE What was the name of the town? She say the name of the town section C was  
6 located in?  
7 LT Here.  
8 CE Okay.  
9 LT Right?  
10 SA How did you meet...  
11 LT I mean...  
12 SA ...how did you meet her?  
13 LT She come down at the.. when Publix.. Publix on.. the first Publix on  
14 Chickasaw and Lake Underhill.  
15 SA You met her over this case you didn't know her prior to Caylee..  
16 LT No, no.  
17 SA ....going missing?  
18 LT No.  
19 SA You met her because she..  
20 LT She wanted to..  
21 SA She got involved and you got involved...  
22 LT She wanted to know where George was that day.  
23 SA Right.

1 LT She come down to the tent. And George wasn't there and I didn't know where  
2 he was. And she gave me her number to give to ...  
3 SA Right.  
4 LT ...George. And I gave her my number if she wanted to volunteer.  
5 SA Right.  
6 LT Well ever since then she's been calling me. And I...  
7  
8 SA Right.  
9 LT ...call her too.  
10 SA Right. Okay.  
11 CE In your conversations with George, I wanted to touch upon , well, is there  
12 another person that we met through the tent that we had talked about?  
13 Joy Wray, is that then name?  
14 LT (No verbal response)  
15 CE Did Joy Wray come to the tent as well?  
16 LT Yes I met Joy a couple of times. I know um, she was a.. at first she was a  
17 protestor across the street from the Anthony's.  
18 SA How did you know that?  
19 LT She told me.  
20 SA She was a protester?  
21 LT Joy.  
22 SA Right.  
23 LT Joy.  
24 SA Okay.

1 LT Then I met her um, I met her at the tent a couple of times and then she was out  
2 at Blanchard Park one time I met her. Um, and then I met her back down at the  
3 tent again in front of FEMA. And she was talking to George and her and her  
4 husband were down there.

5 CE You had said that she mentioned searching the area on suburban. Can you tell  
6 me about that again?

7 LT Correct. She had told me after you had found the body that she said, that body  
8 was not there prior to this. 'Cause she had been down there.

9 SA Right.

10 CE She say how she'd been down there? What capacity? Was she searching with  
11 EquuSearch...

12 LT She was with...

13 CE ..or on her own?

14 LT ...EquuSearch. She was with EquuSearch. She said she was in that area all  
15 over that area a couple of times. And that the body was not there.

16 SA Did she say she had went back there by herself or did she say she went there  
17 with EquuSearch?

18 LT She didn't say. She just said the body wasn't there.

19 SA Did she say why she was there?

20 LT She went with EquuSearch.

21 SA Okay.

22 CE When did this conversation take placed?

23 LT After you found the body. I mean...

1 SA How long after  
2 LT Not long after 'cause I haven't seen her for quite a while I mean.  
3 SA Did she ah, did she say that, ah, did she say that she had contacted the police  
4 or did she talk to y'all about ah...  
5 LT No.  
6 SA Did she ah, um, did she say what made her switch from being a protestor to  
7 being friends with Anthony's?  
8 LT Yeah down at the tent one time 'cause George didn't know that she was a  
9 protestor.  
10 SA Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
11 LT And I had told George 'cause she was sitting there talking to George and I  
12 told him. He said, really? And I said, ah, yeah and then he asked her and she  
13 said, yeah I was until I heard everything that was going on and then I realized  
14 that you went to see her or something like that. She believed in George she  
15 believed Caylee was alive.  
16 SA How long after we found the body did this, did she develop this.. all this  
17 happened?  
18 LT What that...  
19 SA Where she said that she'd switched when she realized George was sincere?  
20 LT Oh no when she said George was sincere this was before.. they found, they  
21 found the...  
22 SA Before we found the body?  
23 LT ....body. Yes.

1 SA Did you have conversations with her after we found the body?  
2 LT Yeah I think it was one time it wasn't too long after I don't know the date. She  
3 had said that that body was not there.  
4 SA Right.  
5 LT Be... prior.  
6 SA Well it had... right. At.. at the time that she told you the body wasn't there. I'm  
7 talking about after the body was found and she..  
8 LT Okay.  
9 SA ...made these assertions and the body wasn't there.  
10 LT Right.  
11 SA Did she talk to you at that point? Um, was she still friendly with the Anthony's  
12 at that point?  
13 LT Yeah I think so I can't... I don't know. I..  
14 SA You just...  
15 LT ....was never in their company other then down at the table with George and  
16 her a couple of times and her husband.  
17 SA Did she ever say to you that the Anthony's or George Anthony in particular  
18 Had brainwashed her?  
19 LT No.  
20 SA Did she ever tell you that she was a spy for the government or for the president  
21 ah for President Bush?  
22 LT No.  
23 SA Did he ever tell you that she knew George Bush personally?

1 LT No.

2 CE Did she ever tell you that she was in section C?

3 LT Joy?

4 CE Joy.

5 LT No.

6 SA But you're sure she never made any accretions that she either worked for the  
7 Government, that she was a spy for the government or that she knew President  
8 Bush personally? Or that the Anthony's brainwashed her?  
9

10 LT No.

11 SA Okay. Would it surprise you if she told somebody else this?

12 LT I can't say 'cause I don't know the girl that well.

13 SA Yeah.

14 LT I mean I don't..

15 CE Well, you did say though that when you discussed her where do we find these?  
16 And I can't remember exactly how you phrased it.

17 LT Yeah she was out there. Say that she was..

18 CE That means in layman terms...

19 LT Well she wanted to be involved in everything I mean...

20 CE Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

21 LT You know. I, I...

22 CE You think she's credible?

23 LT I don't know her. I mean...

24 SA Would it surprise you of these things I just asked you about being a spy and

25

1 knowing the president and being brainwashed if she told those things to us?

2 LT She could've I don't know.

3 SA Could've told us or, or you think there's any possibility these things can be true?

4 LT Oh no I don't think they're true.

5 SA Okay.

6 LT No I don't think they're true.

7 CE Okay. Um, I guess one last thing. In conversations with George they couldn't

8 really explain away the car or the smell in the car. What, what happened there

9 when that was discussed?

10

11 LT The only thing George had said was, the smell in the car was terrible. And that

12 that was a smell you would never forget.

13 CE He didn't say anymore?

14 LT (No verbal response)

15 CE What did Cindy say about the smell in the car?

16 LT Nothing to me.

17 CE Nothing. Ah, you had made a statement that they said that the smell wasn't in

18 There prior to going to the tow yard. Who made that statement?

19

20 LT George made that statement.

21 CE Where did he make that statement?

22 LT What do you mean?

23 CE Where, where did you witness that statement?

24 LT At the tent.

25 CE At the first tent or is it just, it was kind of a common theme?

1 LT Probably about the second tent.

2 CE So...

3 LT Not the first.

4 CE ...we're talking at...

5 LT ...location.

6 CE ...the other Publix?

7 LT Yeah.

8 CE So, he kind of was explaining away the fact that the, that someway somehow

9 that, that stench had gotten in the car while it was at the tow yard?

10

11 LT Yes.

12 CE Was his belief?

13 LT Yes.

14 CE Okay. And ah, when we discussed how he may have been able to explain

15 Casey's behavior while the child was missing. You had mentioned that he had a

16 comment about one of the photographs where he was dancing?

17 LT He said, he said, some of them photographs was, was way before Caylee was

18 born. And one of 'em, I don't know which one, was when she was pregnant.

19 CE Excuse me. And these are the... these were the images while she was dancing

20 though?

21

22 LT Yeah the one on TV that were shown on TV. When they first come out.

23 CE At Fusion?

24 LT Yeah.

25 CE At the, at the bar that everyone was talking about.

1 LT Yes. Yes.

2 CE Okay. So, that would've been in, according to George those photographs  
3 were two years old or older.

4 LT Well, yeah.

5 CE Almost three years old.

6 LT Before Caylee when she was pregnant and before yeah.

7 CE So, that, so.. okay. I'm just trying to understand the time line then.

8 SA Did ah, did George or Cindy either one ever mention the name Zeniada or  
9 Zanny in your presence?  
10

11 LT No.

12 SA So, all the time that you worked at that tent. All the time that you were around  
13 them during the search for Caylee... nobody, neither of them never mentioned  
14 Zeniada or Zanny or the nanny or any of that?

15 LT No.

16 SA Where did you...

17 LT They may have mentioned the a baby sitter, but I.. no, not the name.

18 SA Right. What about ah, Dominic Casey did he ever mention Zanny or Zeniada..  
19 or...  
20

21 LT No.

22 SA ...a nanny?

23 LT No.

24 SA Um, how about anybody else associated with this that you met? Ah...

25 LT Just Roxy.

1 SA Okay and Roxy was, Roxy told you that Zanny or Zeniada or the baby sitter  
2 lived out there in Chuluota near her is that...  
3 LT What it was the people across the street.  
4 SA Uh-huh. (affirmative)..  
5 LT ...from her. One was name Linda, one was name Kelly.  
6 SA Right.  
7 LT Linda said to Kelly, "Just tell 'em that the baby sitters name was Zeniada  
8 Fernandez-Gonzales." And the other girl Kelly said to her, like, "shut up  
9 don't say it so loud or whatever. And Linda made the statement that the dumb  
10 bitch across the street don't know what we're talking about. Which meant  
11 Roxy. And she yelled it, Zeniada Fernandez-Gonzales.  
12  
13 SA Well okay.  
14 LT That's the only...  
15 SA Did anybody ever talk in your presence about book deals or movie deals or  
16 getting money for pictures or...  
17 LT No.  
18 SA Okay.  
19 CE What was the conversation regarding Texas EquuSearch? Who invited them?  
20 Going to Orlando.  
21  
22 LT I believe Cindy and George had called them to look for Caylee. But I believe  
23 they called them to look for a live body. I'm sorry, a live person.  
24 CE And this was when?  
25 LT I don't know when they first come out I don't know when they come out.

1 CE So, you witnessed George and Cindy talking about that or...

2 LT No, either George or Cindy told me I don't know which one told me. That they

3 had called. Well I guess when EquuSearch came here and started looking

4 in the, the woods and the ponds and whatever. Um, I guess George and Cindy

5 had stopped talking to Tim Miller.

6 CE Okay.

7 LT Because of this. And Cindy had made the statement that she'd never talked to

8 him again. Because I guess she had called him to look for a live body and he's

9 out looking in the woods and ponds and whatever.

10

11 CE Did they, did the Anthony's ever tell you why they changed lawyers?

12 LT No.

13 CE No.

14 LT No.

15 SA So, your understanding...

16 LT Yes.

17 SA Well we'll stop here. Go ahead.

18 LT Yes. Because Mark.

19 CE Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

20 LT DeJame?

21 SA Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

22 LT Had told 'em not to go on a TV show. I don't know which one.

23 SA Okay.

24 LT A talk show, TV show.

25

1 SA Right.

2 LT And they went anyway. And I guess he said, if you can't listen to what I tell  
3 you not to do. It's over. And then I guess that's when they got this lawyer.

4 SA So, who told you that?

5 LT George.

6 SA So, George told you that Mr. NeJame had asked 'em not to go on TV show.  
7 They disregard it as legal advise and did what they wanted to do. And that  
8 resulted in ...

9

10 LT Correct.

11 SA ....them parting ways.

12 LT Correct. Now I don't know which one it was. I think it.. I need to think  
13 Larry King... but I'm not sure.

14 SA Okay. Um, and just to cover the, the disagreements with EquuSearch. Um,  
15 the reason they indicated to you they were upset with Tim Miller and  
16 EquuSearch was 'cause essentially they, he was not doing what they wanted him  
17 to do? They were...

18 LT Correct.

19 SA ...he was searching the way he believed was right. And they weren't... and  
20 they weren't searching in a way that.. he was searching in... He was conducting  
21 the search in of course with what he believed. And...

22

23 LT I think he was looking for a dead body.

24 SA Right and..

25 LT Basically.

1 SA Right.

2 LT And they, I guess he had promised them he was gonna look for Caylee.

3 SA Okay.

4 LT A live body. And I don't think he did that from day one when he come out.

5 SA Okay. And so they were upset with him because he, he was doing what he

6 wanted to do not what they wanted him to do. Is that... He was searching

7 they wanted him to search.

8

9 LT Correct.

10 SA ..one way.

11 LT Not what they, not what Cindy and George wanted him to do and not what he

12 Promised them he would do when they, they called him.

13 CE Okay let me ask some questions there maybe shed some light through that

14 means.

15 Um, did George or Cindy ever discuss with you when they had EquuSearch

16 in the home. That Baez was there as well?

17 LT No.

18 CE Okay. Now the period of time where Casey got out of jail and was back

19 in the home. Thanks to Mr. Padilla and his efforts. Did they ever say that

20 she was cooperating with them and providing them information that would

21 lead to the location to the child?

22

23 LT No.

24 CE Did they ever express any frustration that she was doing nothing to help

25 locate the child? Did George ever say anything about that?

1 LT No.

2 CE Did anyone question him, hey has Casey said anything to help in, in this  
3 search?

4 LT I would ask how Casey was doing? And um, I know one morning he was so  
5 mad at her he come down at the tent early. And he said, I just had to get out the  
6 house.

7 CE Why?

8 LT He didn't say he was upset with Casey.

9 CE Okay.

10 LT I don't.. he didn't elaborate on why or ...

11 SA So, this massive search is going on. It's on the news every night.

12 LT Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

13 SA Um, the police, the FBI or um, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.  
14 All this searching is going on across the country. EquuSearch is here with  
15 thousands of volunteers searching and nobody asked if Casey would help or  
16 ah, was Casey cooperating? I mean nobody at the tent ever said wow we're  
17 out here manning this tent trying to find Caylee. Um, there's a huge search  
18 going on organized by EquuSearch. Um, the police are out searching, but  
19 Caylee... or Casey's not helping? No one saw... did, did.. was there ever a  
20 Point where anybody at the tent thought that was odd or asked George or  
21 Cindy well how come, how come Casey's not helping?

22 LT He didn't want people down from... he didn't want people at the tent from  
23 EquuSearch.

24  
25

1 SA No my, my question is, is that you remember the time EquuSearch was here.  
2 EquuSearch came here a couple of times.  
3 LT Right.  
4 SA They got lots of volunteers to help search for, for Caylee. Regardless of  
5 whether or not they searching the ay George and Cindy would like 'em to  
6 search, they were searching.  
7  
8 LT Right.  
9 SA People from this town all got together and went down and volunteered. You guys  
10 Kid Finders ya'll had a tent. You had people coming down volunteering their  
11 own time to help look for Caylee.  
12 LT Correct.  
13 SA All that's correct okay. Was there ever a point in time where anybody said, wait a  
14 Minute we're all out here . You got all these young people out here helping to  
15 Look for Caylee. How come Casey is not providing information or how come  
16 Casey's not helping? Casey's the missing child's mother. Did anybody ever ask  
17 George and Cindy that question?  
18 LT I don't know in them words.  
19 SA Stand-by. (phone)  
20  
21 LT I don't in them words I've asked George a couple of times you know has Casey  
22 said anything and he would tell me. She can only say so much to protect  
23 Caylee and the family.  
24 SA She can only protect so much.. say so much.  
25 LT Say so much yeah.

1 SA That Caylee and the family.

2 LT To protect Caylee and the family.

3 SA Okay.

4 LT She's, she's protecting us and I took it that she can't talk 'cause if she talks  
5 they would harm Caylee or harm Cindy or George or Lee or...

6 SA Well. Okay.

7 CE So, back to the EquuSearch thing. Tim Miller, if Tim brings resources here and  
8 he sits in the house with the family. And he's denied access to the last person  
9 that saw the child that we can establish...How would he start his search?  
10

11 LT I don't know.

12 CE If you were at the tent and people are asking how can we help what information  
13 do you have? How could you answer their question?

14 LT Well we, we would say to the people that asked.

15 CE Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

16 LT Um, we'll find her Caylee's alive.

17 CE But my question is if someone walked up and says, where can I start looking?  
18 What information do you have? I'll put this T-shirt on I'll hang these posters  
19 but where can I start looking to help? Now here Kid Finders I'm just going  
20 off the title here. Kid Finders seems like they're just in the title and in of itself  
21 looks like there's some form of effort to find a child.

22

23 LT Uh-huh. (affirmative)..

24 CE So, if someone walked up and I'm not, you're not, you volunteered to work there.  
25 But my question be if you're helping Kid Finders and some said where can I

1 start to look. What information do you have? Just from talking to you your  
2 Answer would be, well really none. Other than a picture of this missing  
3 child.  
4 LT And if you see her please contact ...  
5 CE Right.  
6 LT ...the police department tips.  
7 CE So, here and bear with me. Here's a girl on TV 'cause the unfortunately the  
8 visitation video's with her parents. "I can't do anything from in here. I can't  
9 help until I'm out." Okay. And Leonard Padilla. Your wish granted through  
10 unconventional means but you're out. Same time Tim Miller rolls into town.  
11 And you guys are doing what you're doing. But now here she is home, sitting  
12 in the house.  
13 LT I didn't think she was allowed to come out.  
14 CE Well, I'm... I'm.. but her mouth works.  
15 LT Oh.  
16 CE And there's all these people out doing what she could be doing. But her  
17 mouth works. She could've... The point we're trying to make is and we're..  
18 asking you 'cause maybe through this conversation something will spark  
19 a memory. There was never an information source from her directly other  
20 then the bunk that was provided to these two, to John and Yuri from the  
21 onset.  
22 SA Did ah..  
23 LT Just...

1 SA ...she ever say to you ah, did George or Cindy ever say the reason ah,  
2 Casey took the detectives ad showed 'em an empty apartment said that's  
3 Zenieda's Gonzales apartment? And them took ;em out to Universal to  
4 show her ah, show them her office. Is, and they gave a reason. I mean  
5 essentially what I'm asking you is... did anybody ever say to you, why Casey just  
6 told us a whole bunch of lies?  
7  
8 LT No I asked George why 'cause I..  
9  
10 SA Why?  
11  
12 LT ...seen it on TV all of course.  
13  
14 SA Yeah.  
15  
16 LT I don't know.,  
17  
18 SA You're a mother. You have children?  
19  
20 LT Yes.  
21  
22 SA Let me ask you, what would it take for you for one of your children to go  
23 missing and you to not report it for over a month? Ah, or actually not report  
24 it at all and then when it got reported lie to the police and point 'em in a  
25 different directions to make it harder for them to find your child. What  
would it, what would make you do that? Can you think of anything?  
26  
27 LT No.  
28  
29 SA Okay.  
30  
31 CE Now we're trying to come up with answers. I have a question.  
32  
33 LT I wouldn't do that.  
34  
35 CE Clarification on an answer you gave him a second ago. So, when asked

1 Well why does he tell all those lies? Did you guys ask George that?  
2 Or did anybody ask George why she's told all these stories to the  
3 Police that aren't accurate?  
4 LT Yes.  
5 CE And what was the response?  
6 LT I don't know.  
7 CE He said he doesn't know?  
8 LT Yes. I don't know why she does that.  
9 CE But so that didn't marry into the saying, well she had to do that to protect us?  
10 LT Well he has told me that she could not, she could not give too much  
11 Information. Casey, could not give too much information. Because of  
12 Caylee she's protecting Caylee and she's protecting the family. And I  
13 took it the family to be George, Cindy and Lee.  
14 CE Did he articulate her historical chain of events as a child all the way up  
15 through young adulthood?  
16 LT No.  
17 CE He never told about the money and the lies and the..  
18 LT No I..  
19 CE No.  
20 LGT ... heard that on TV.  
21 CE That was... So, George never offered that himself, that she was a, um, oh I'm  
22 try.. to be professional but she was just a liar?  
23 LT No.

1 CE Okay. I can't think of anything else. So, you don't kind volunteering  
2 to ah, provide that documentation of some phone numbers and that  
3 paperwork that your provided George?  
4 LT Correct it's a list it's a ...  
5 CE Okay.  
6 LT ....on regular white copy paper.  
7 CE Can you raise your right hand for me? Do you swear everything that you said  
8 today is true?  
9 LT Yes.  
10 CE What time do you have?  
11 SA It is about three minutes after two.  
12 CE Conclusion of the interview. Same individuals in the room.
